
JEWISH IDENTIFICATION BY GEOGRAPHIC AREA





SYNAGOGUE ATTENDANCE BY AGE



Types of Marriage by Synagogue Membership








PERCENTAGE OF MARRIED JEWISH PERSONS WHO ARE MARRIED TO NON-JEWS BY AGE




CURRENT RELIGION OF CHILDREN IN INTERMARRIED HOUSEHOLDS

(Children Age 0-17 in Intermarried Jewish Households)




CHILDREN BEING RAISED JEWISH IN INTERMARRIED HOUSEHOLDS

(Jewish Children Age 0-17 in Married Households)




JEWISH CHILDREN WHO ARE BEING RAISED IN CONVERSIONARY IN-MARRIED HOUSEHOLDS




HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN AGE 0-17 AT HOME CONTAINING JEWISH CHILDREN


