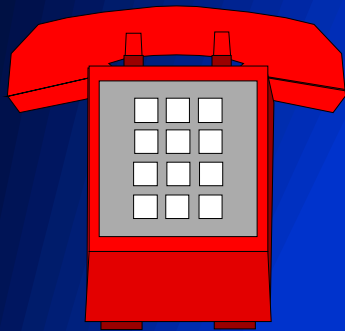

SURVEY METHODOLOGY



Random Digit Dialing

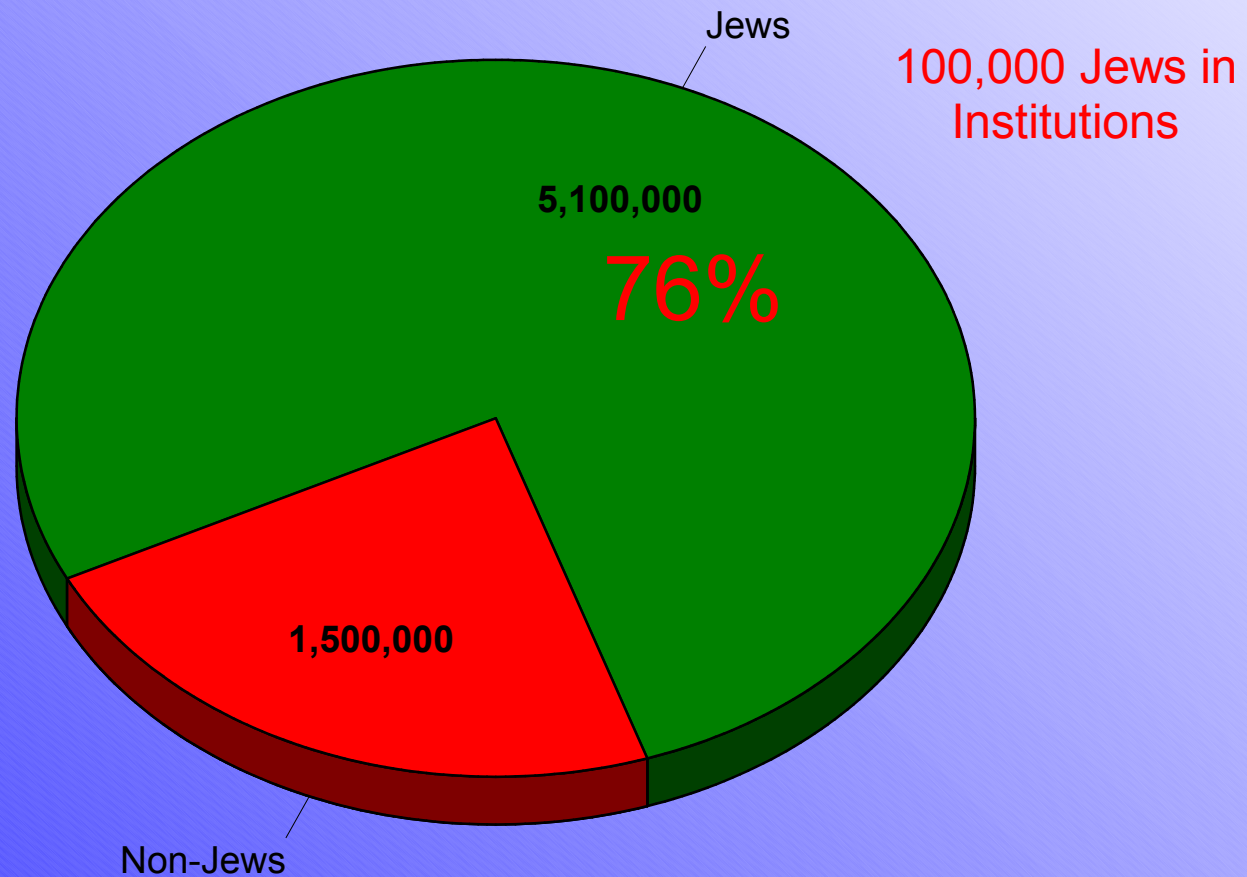
- For every combination of Area Code/Exchange Code in the US, Add 4 Random Numbers to make a 10 digit telephone number.
- This gives every American household (with a telephone) an equal probability of being called.
- The percentage of households reached which are Jewish households can then be applied to the 2000 Census estimate of households to yield an estimate of the number of Jews.
- Oversampling in areas of heavy Jewish concentration and undersampling in lighter areas.

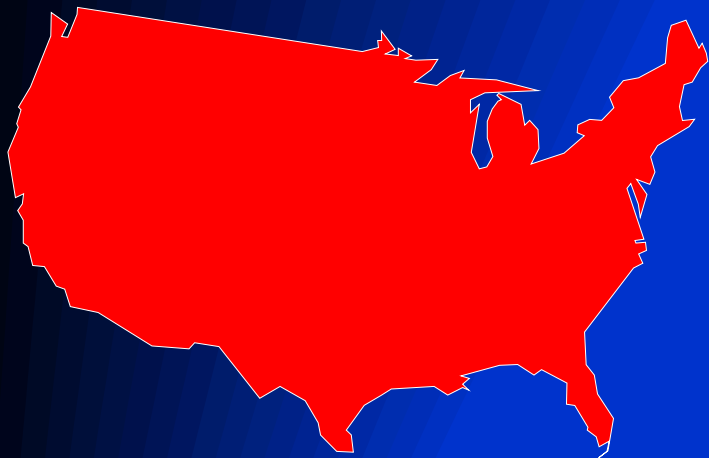

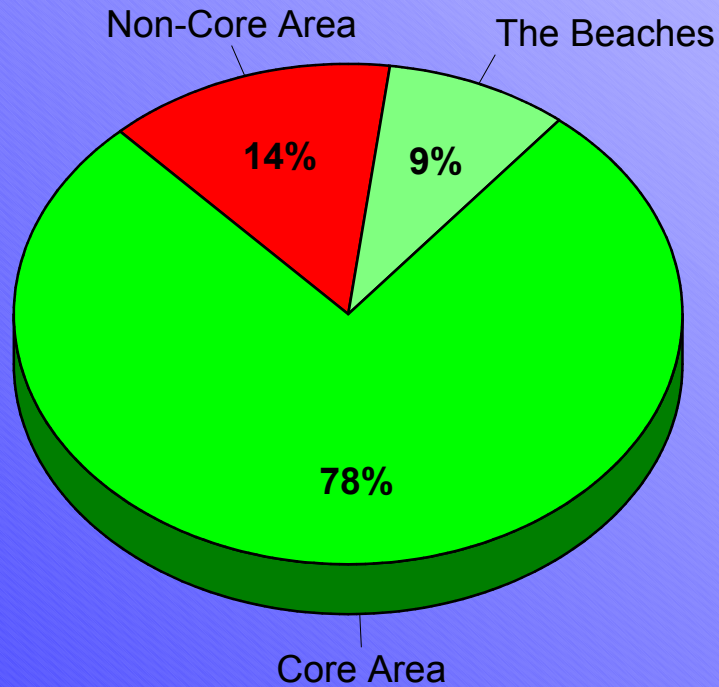

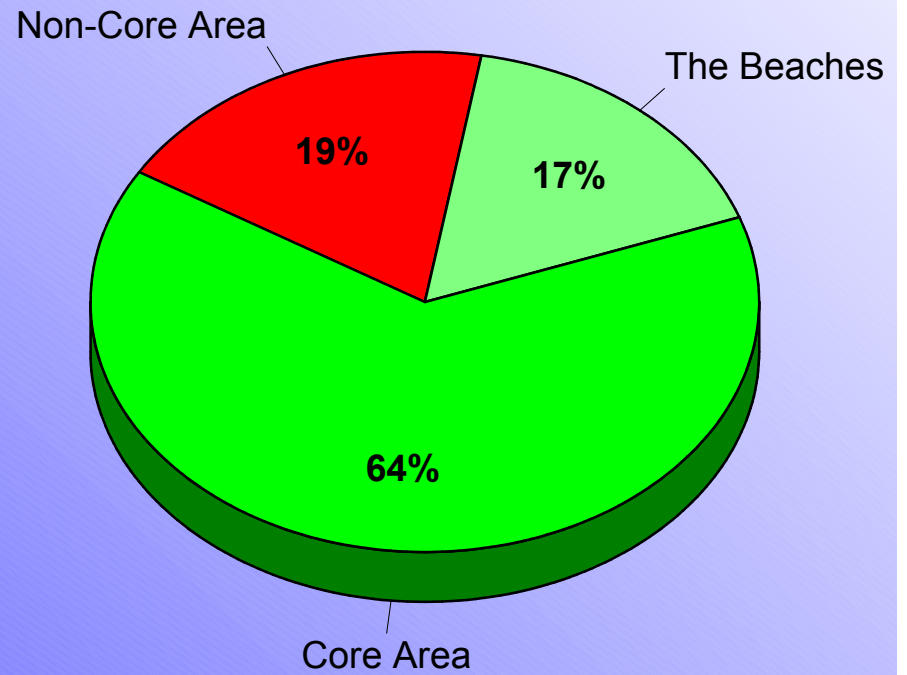

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION OF JEWISH HOUSEHOLDS



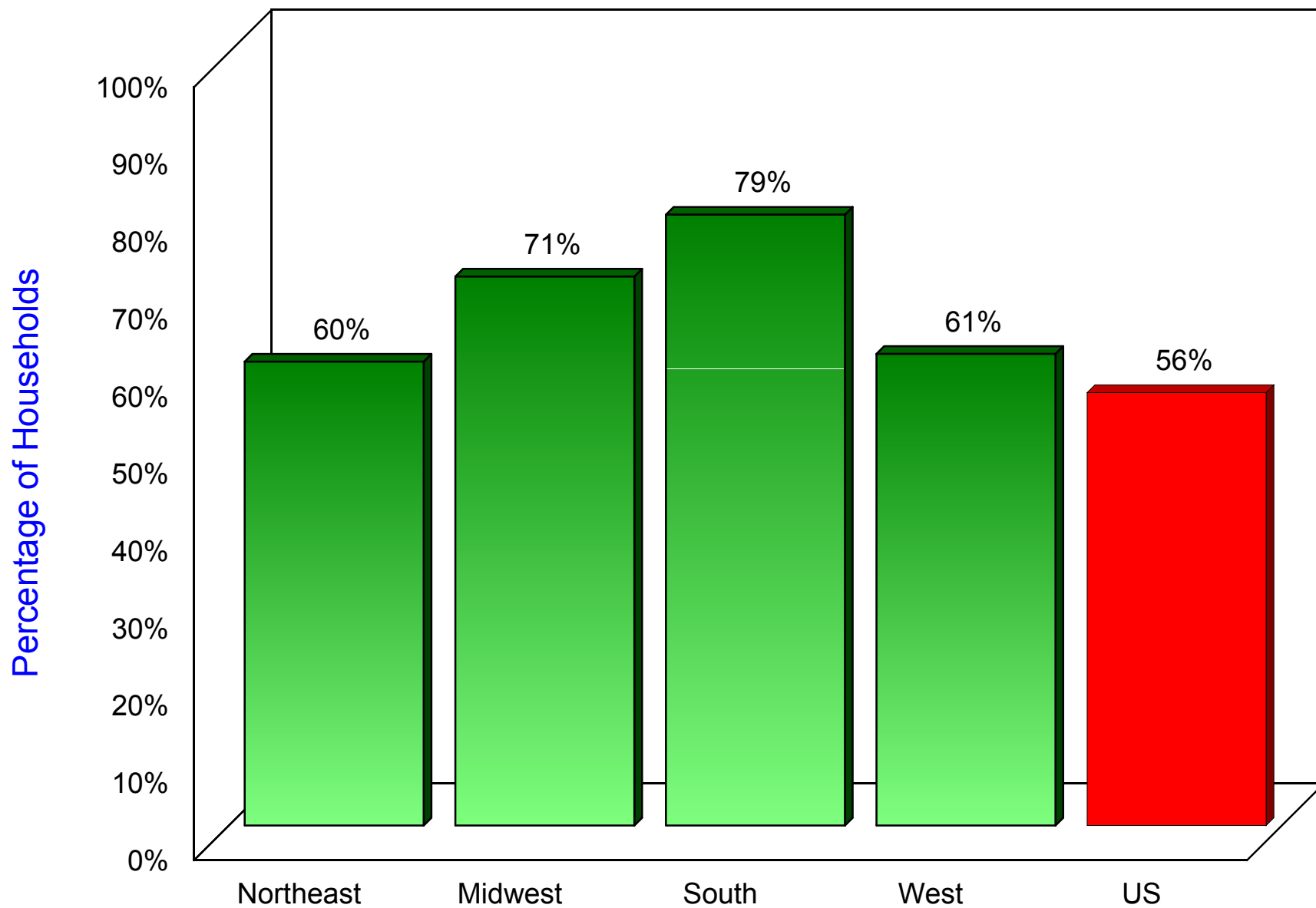

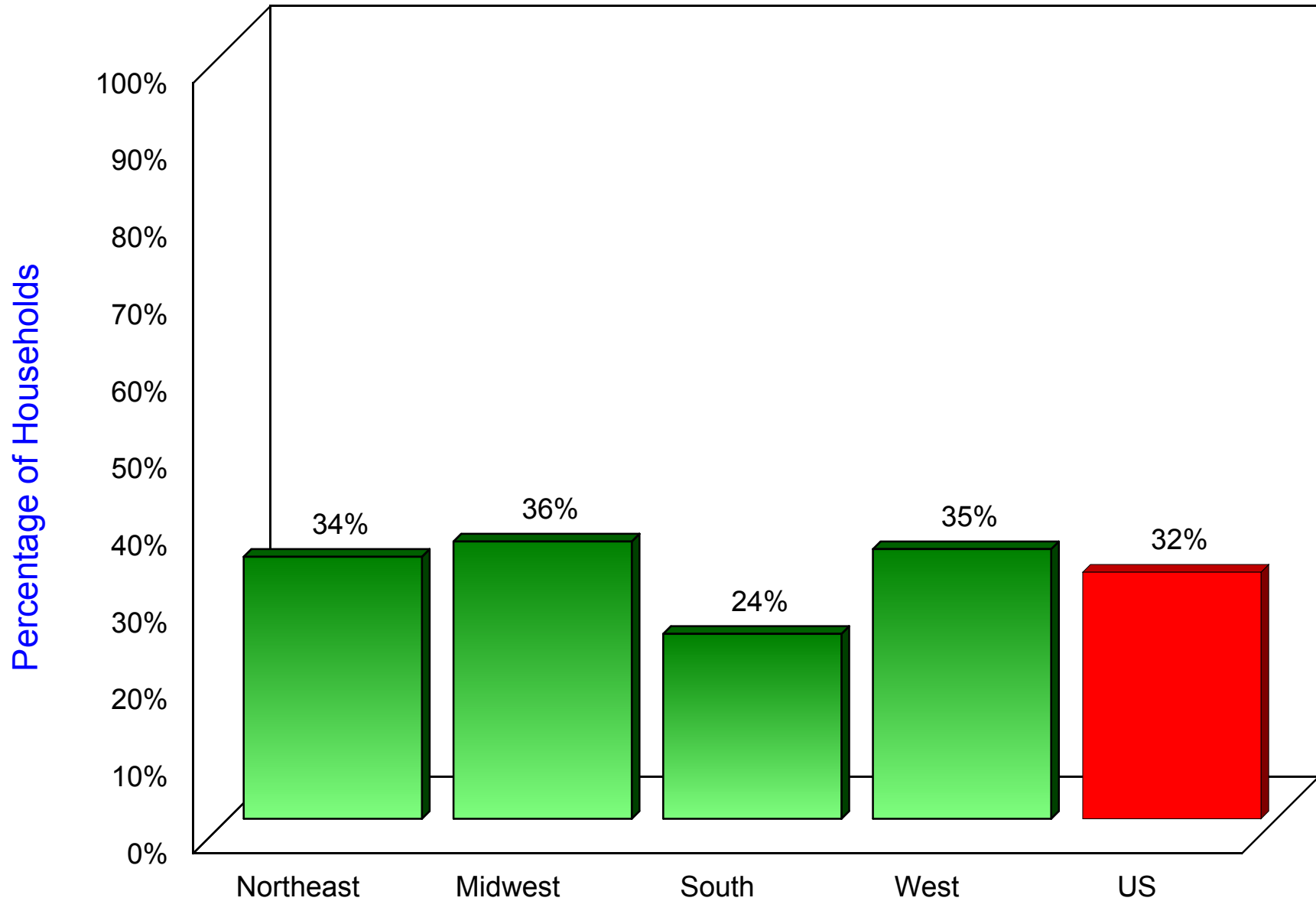
HOME OWNERSHIP



PROBABILITY OF MOVING WITHIN THE NEXT THREE YEARS

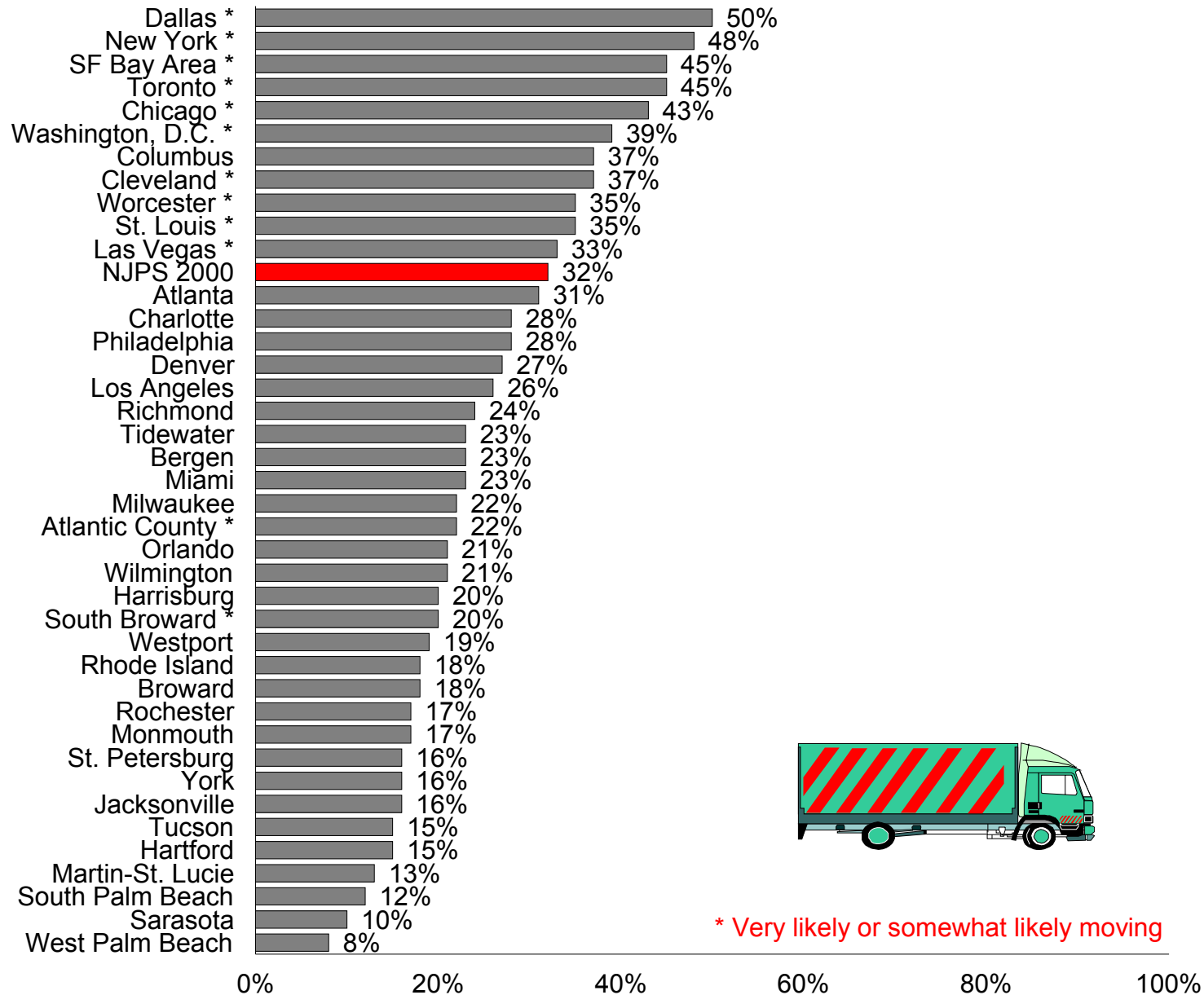


DEFINITELY/PROBABLY MOVING

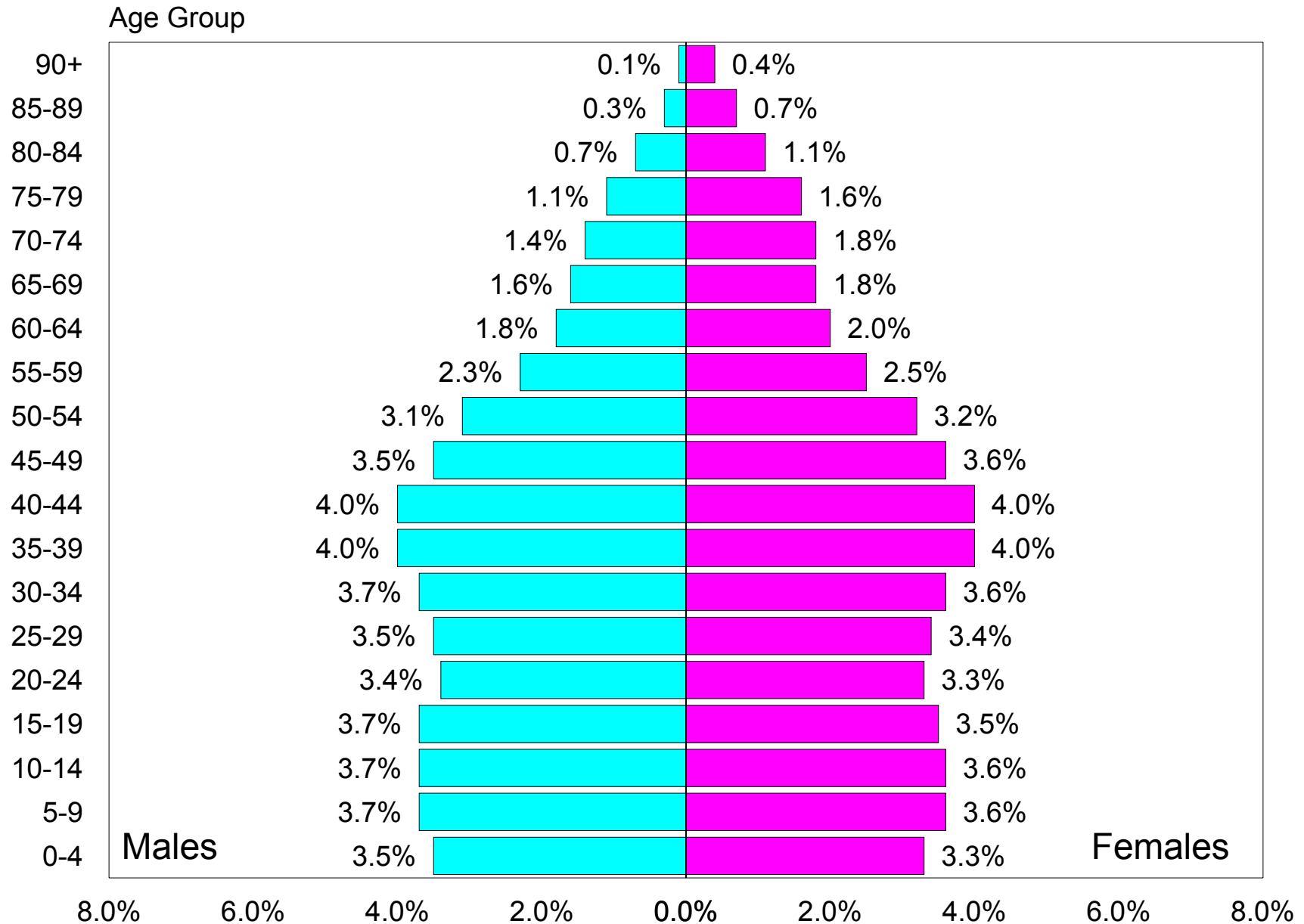

AGE DISTRIBUTION-ALL AMERICANS

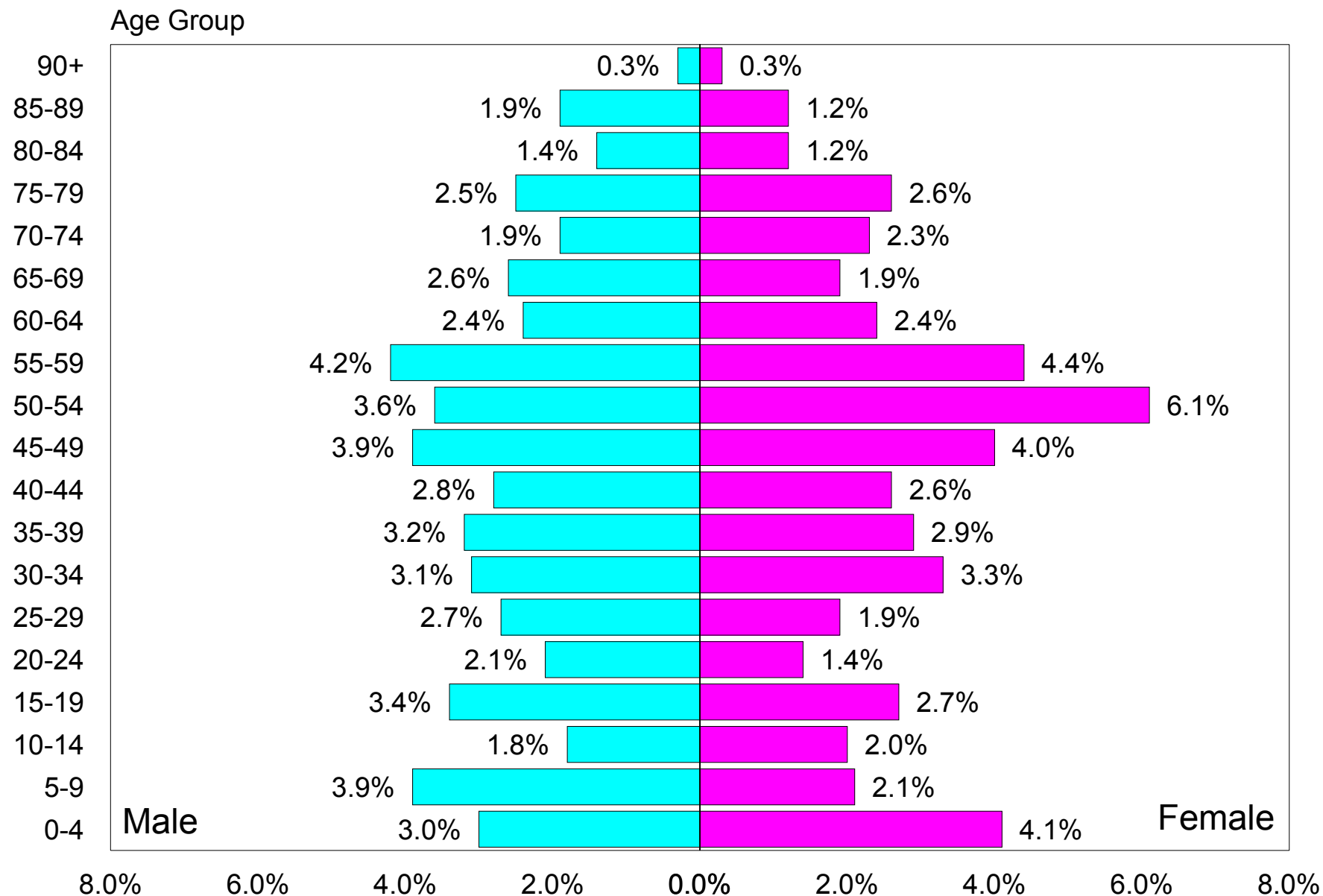

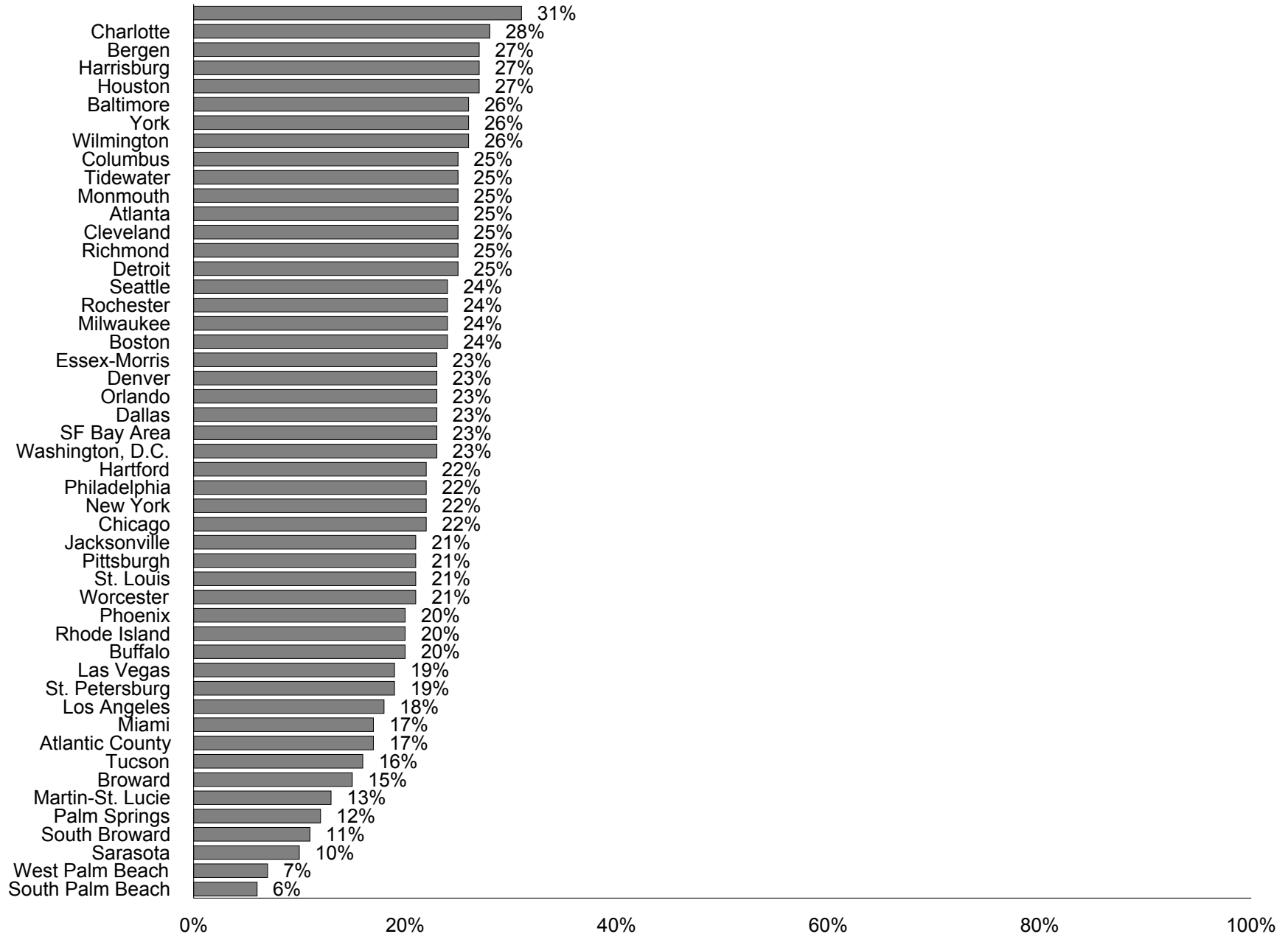
AGE DISTRIBUTION-WASHINGTON

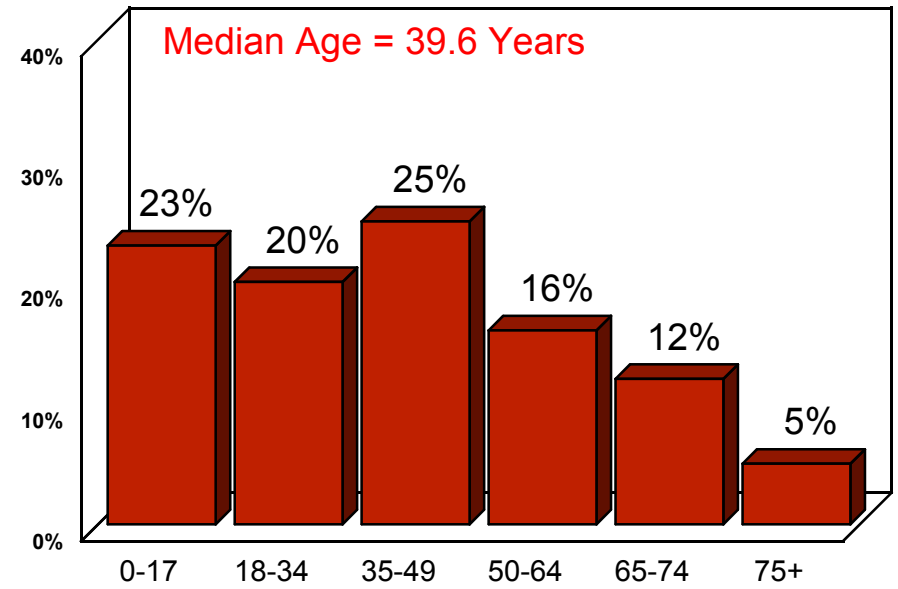


AGE DISTRIBUTION BY GEOGRAPHIC AREA

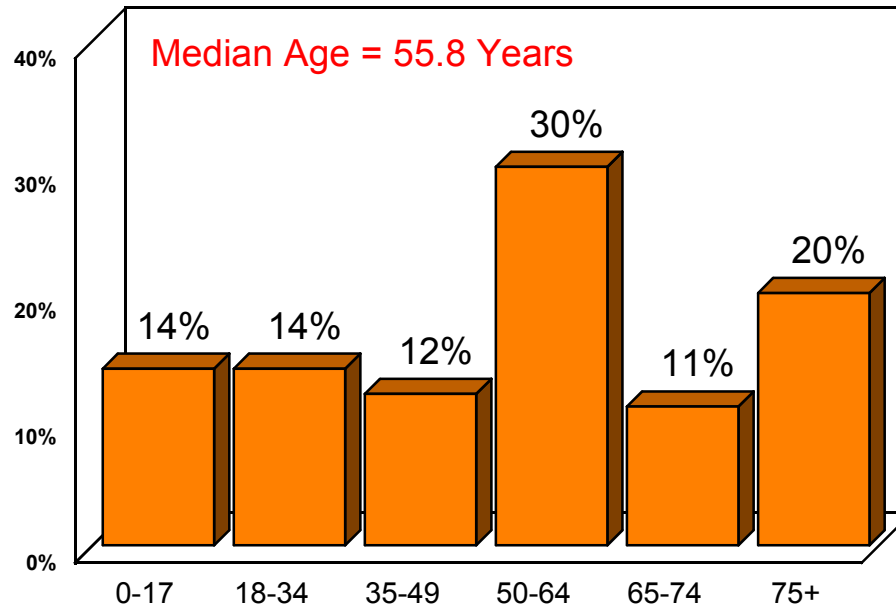

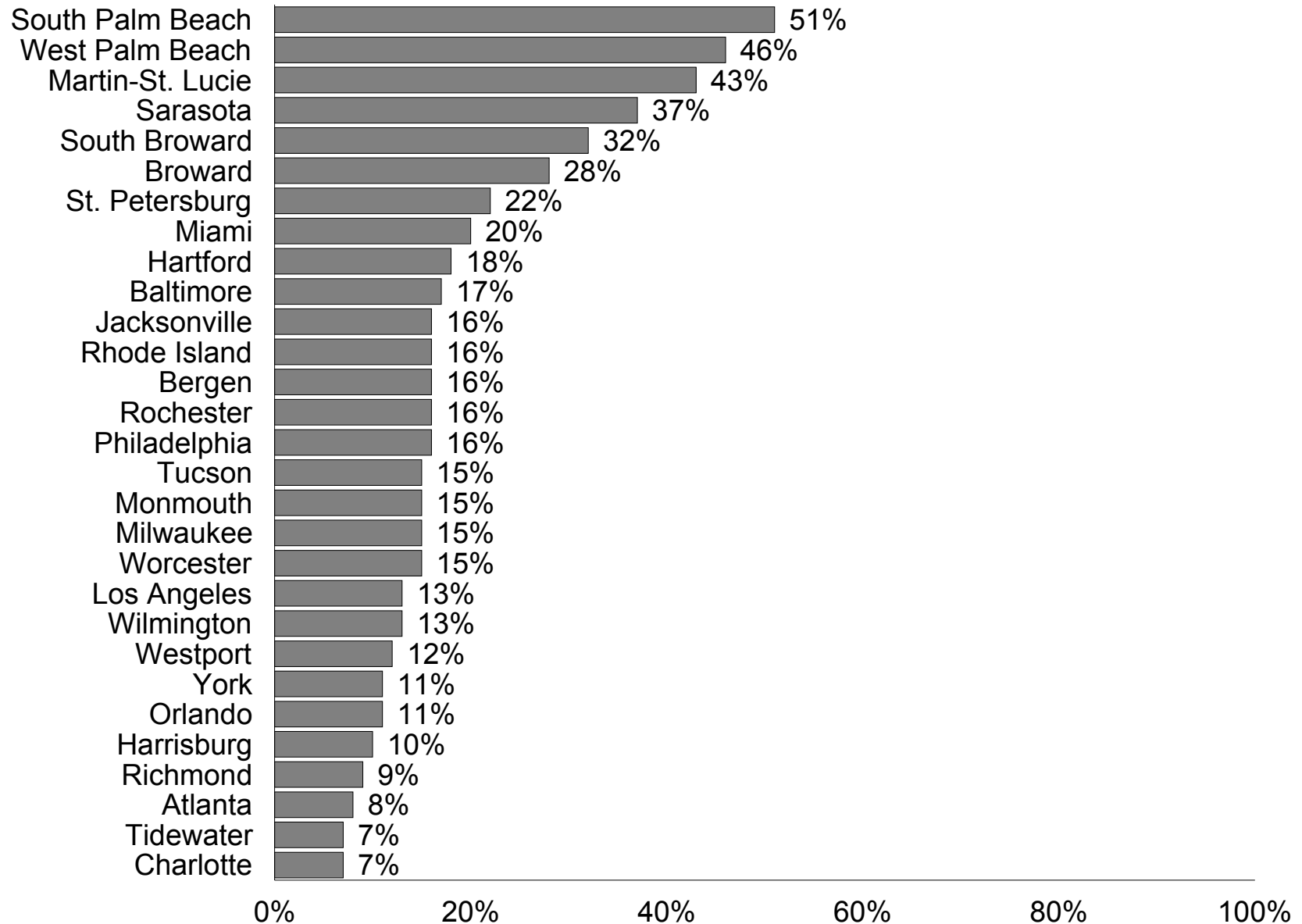
MARRIED HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN AGE 0-17 AT HOME



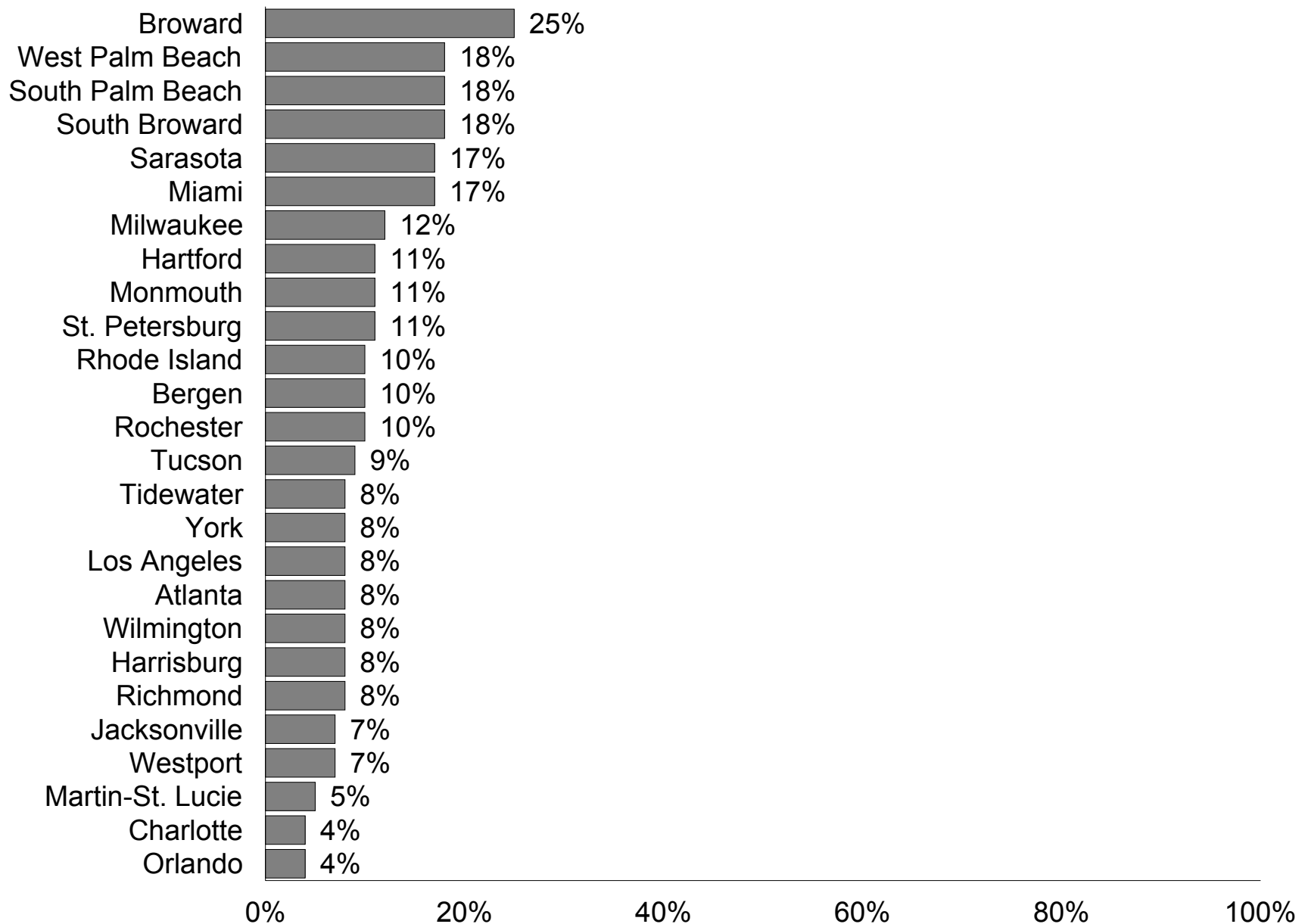

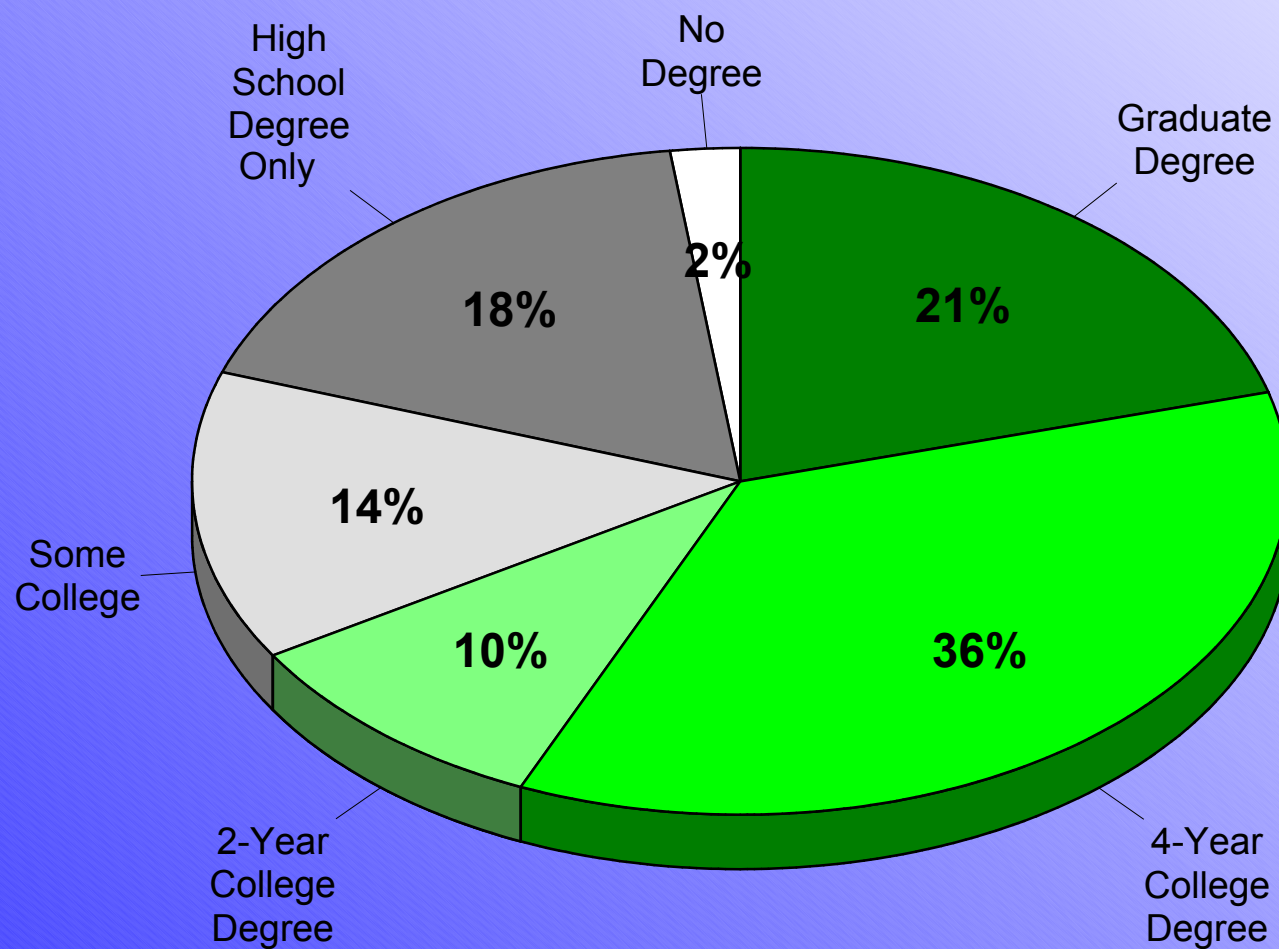
DIVORCE RATE

Percentage of Households in Pie Slice, Percentage of Jews in Labels



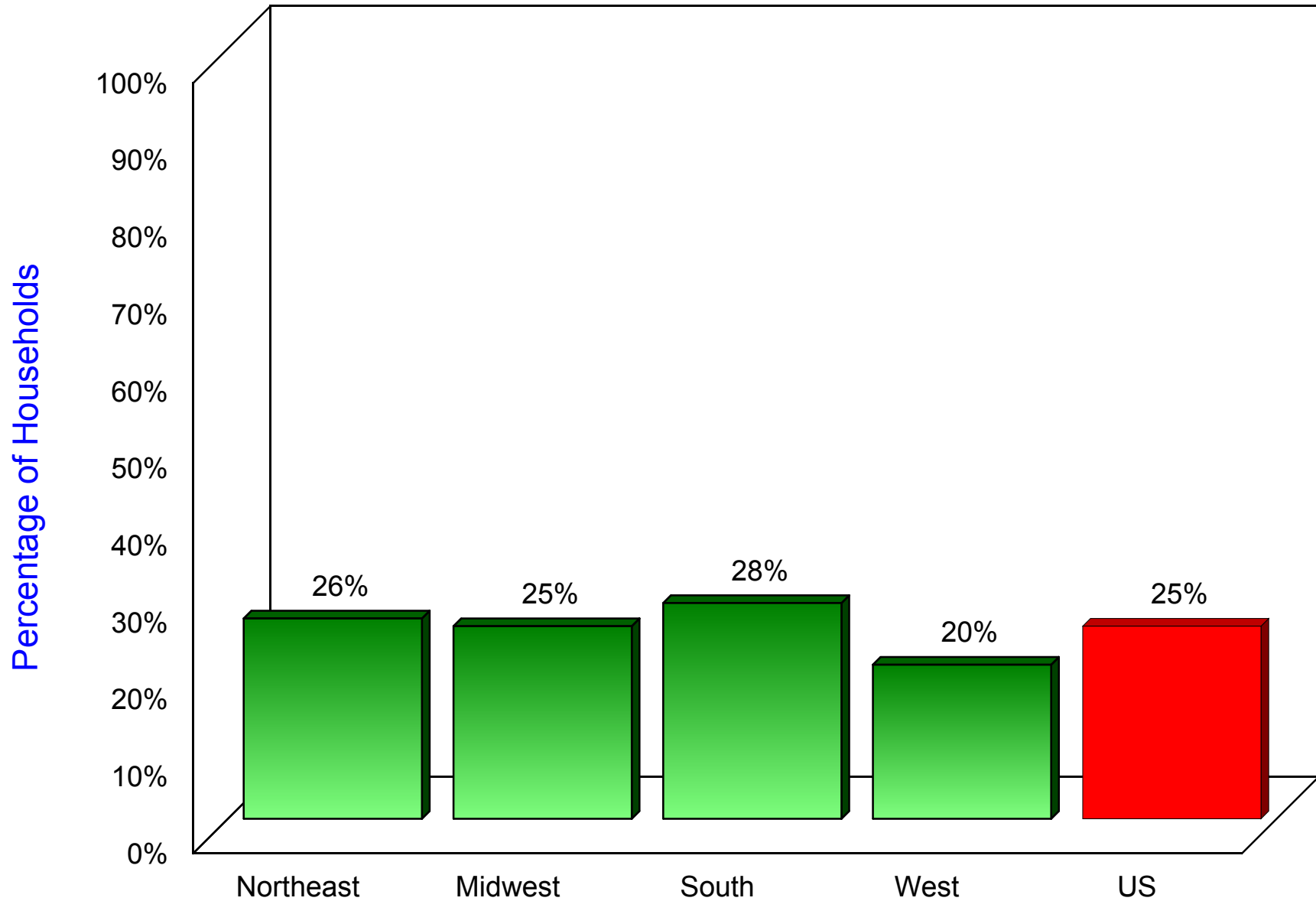

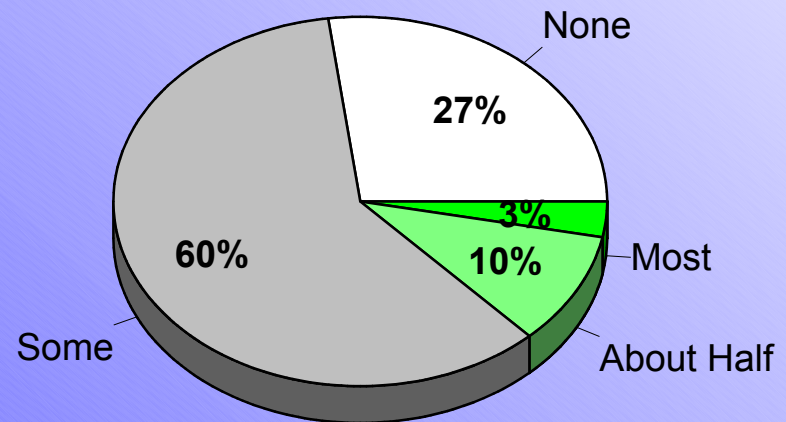


HOW MANY OF YOUR CLOSEST FRIENDS ARE JEWISH?

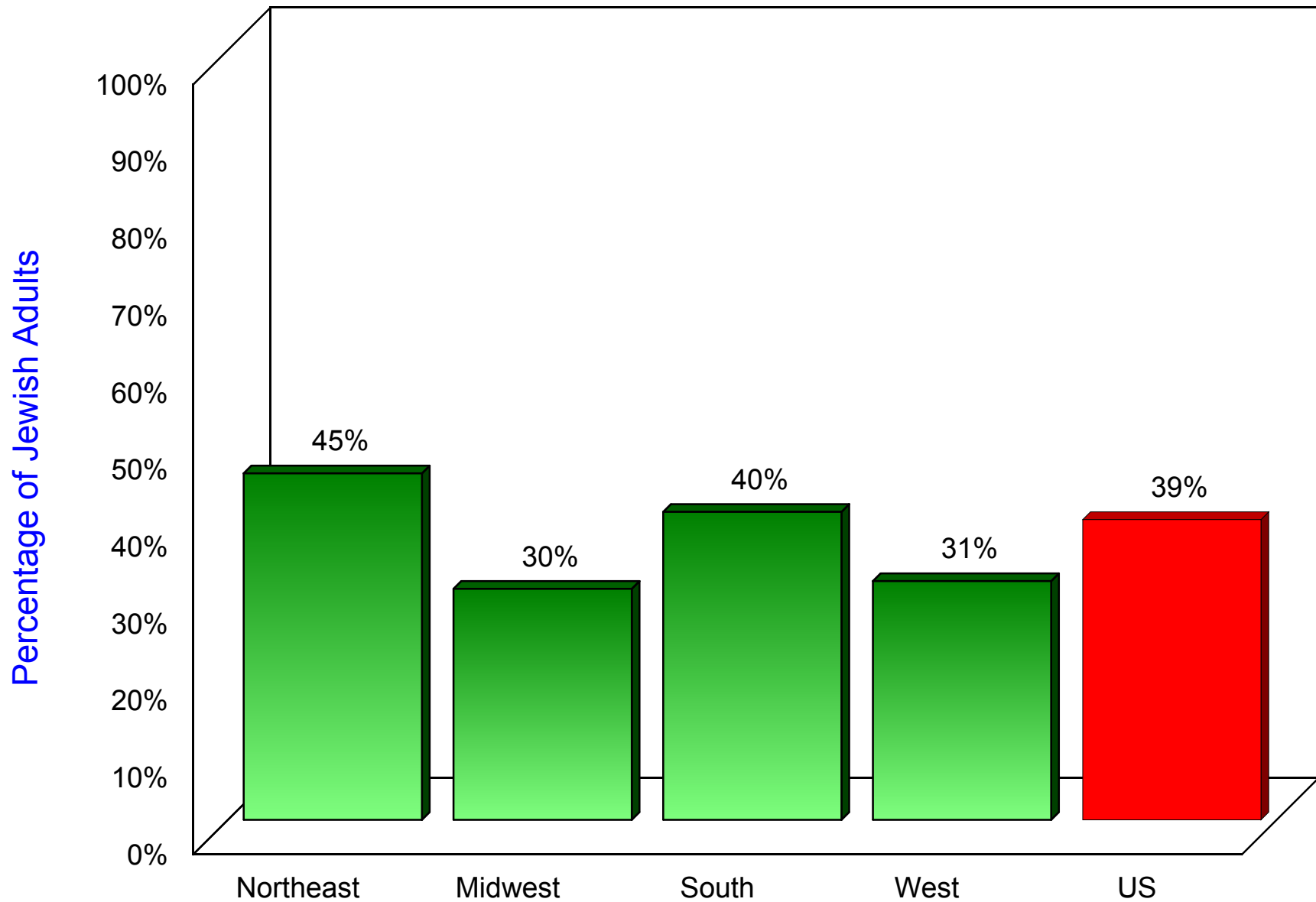

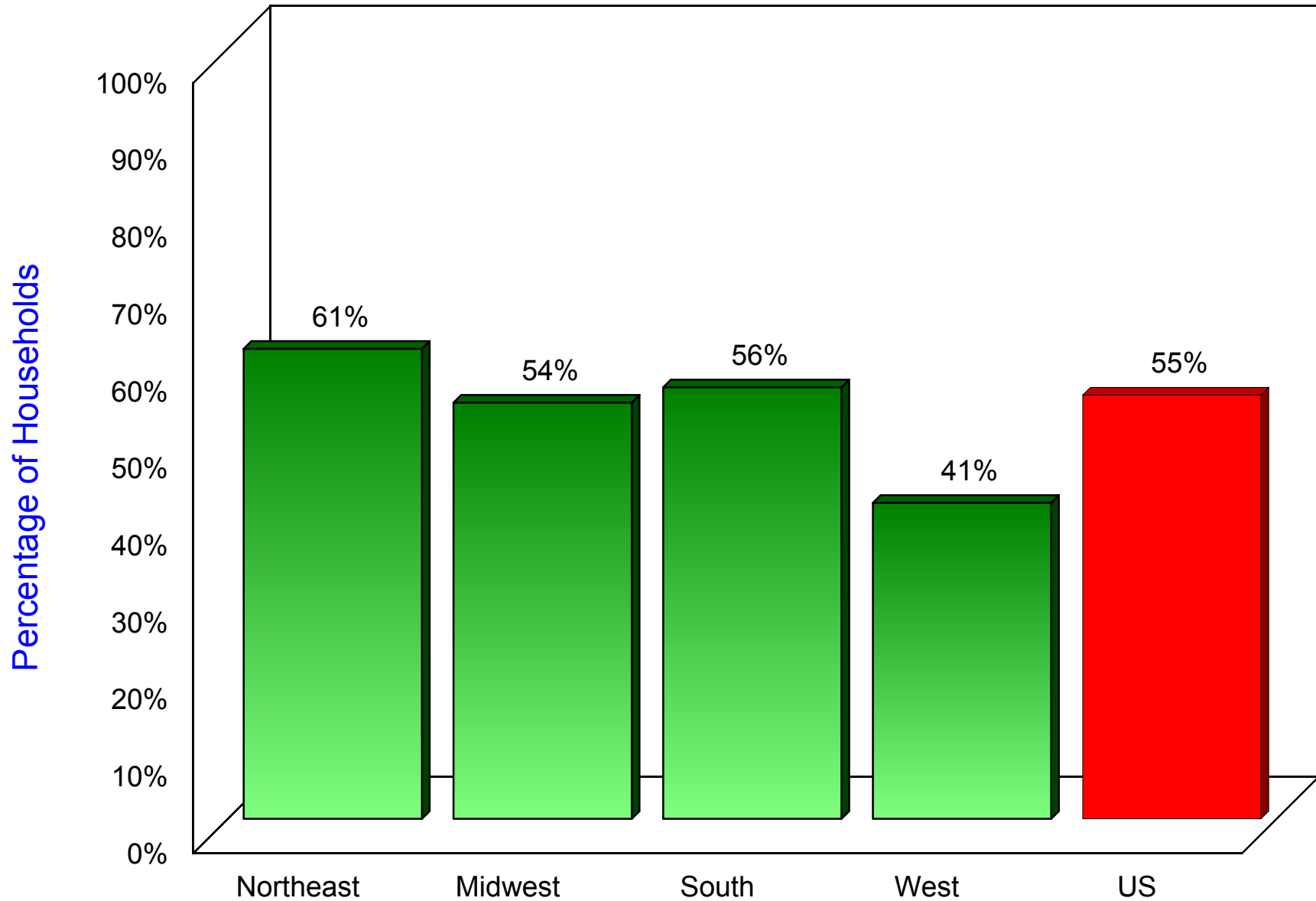

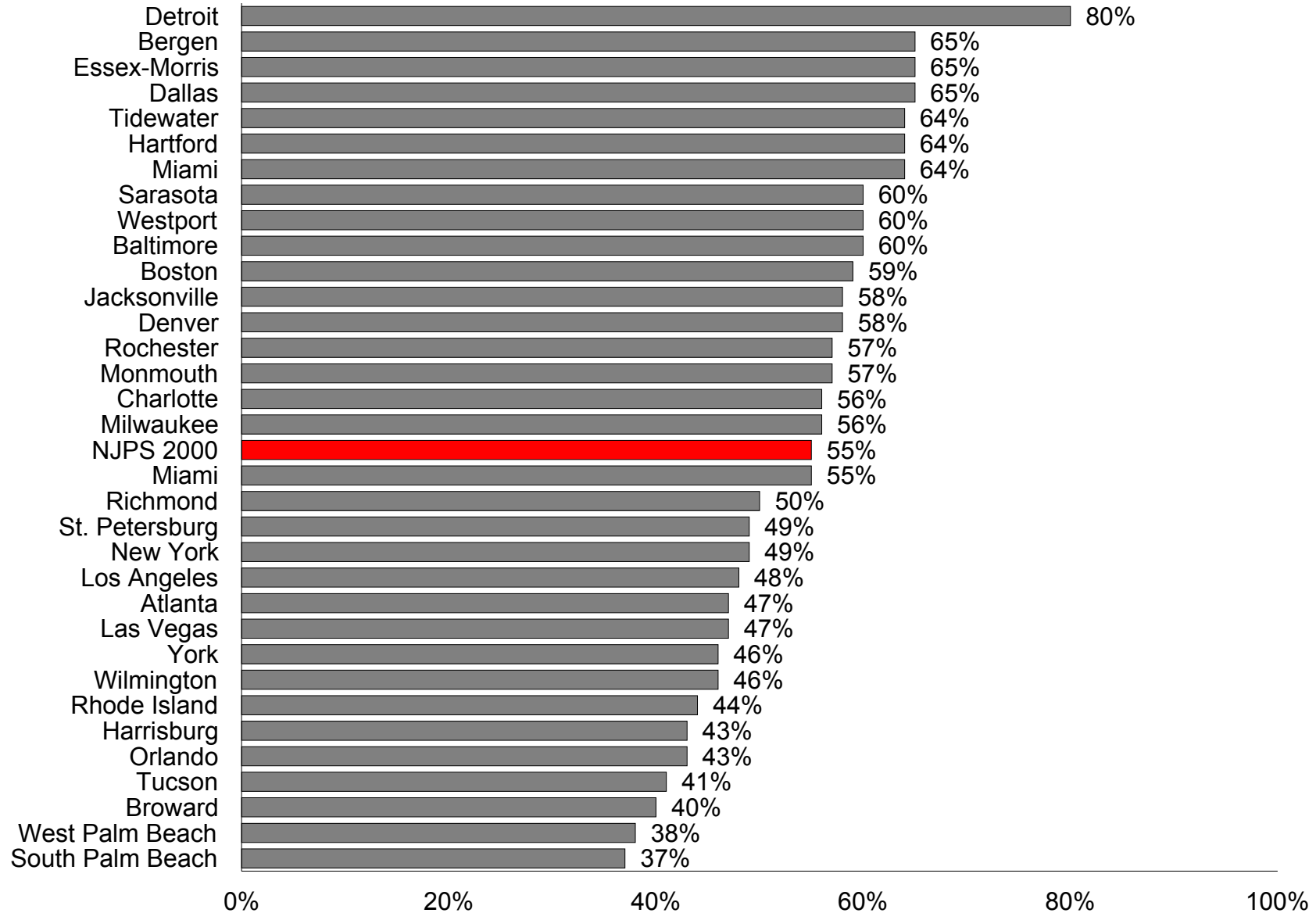


CURRENT REPORTED SYNAGOGUE MEMBERSHIP IN HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN

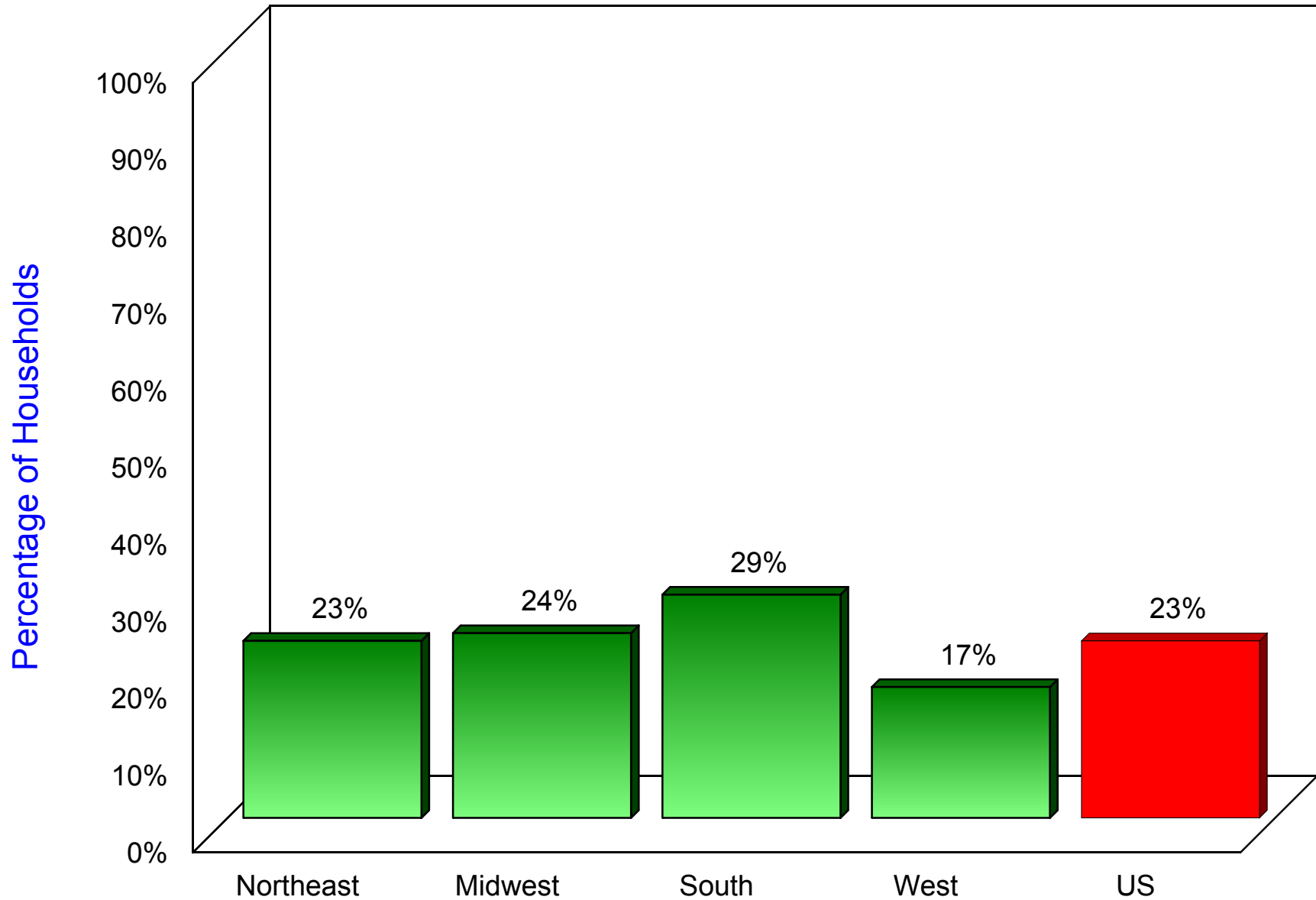

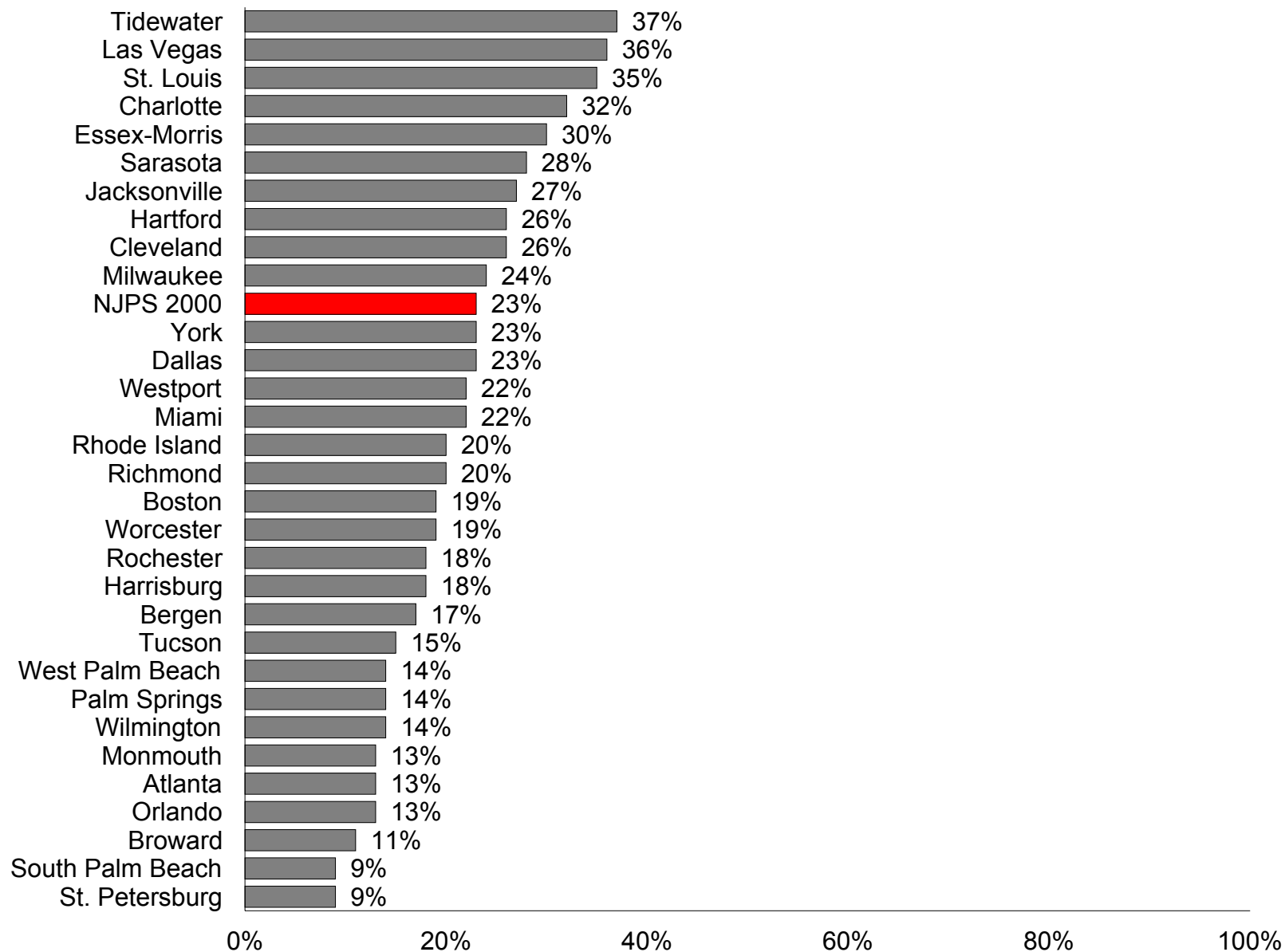


CURRENT REPORTED SYNAGOGUE MEMBERSHIP IN INTERMARRIED HOUSEHOLDS

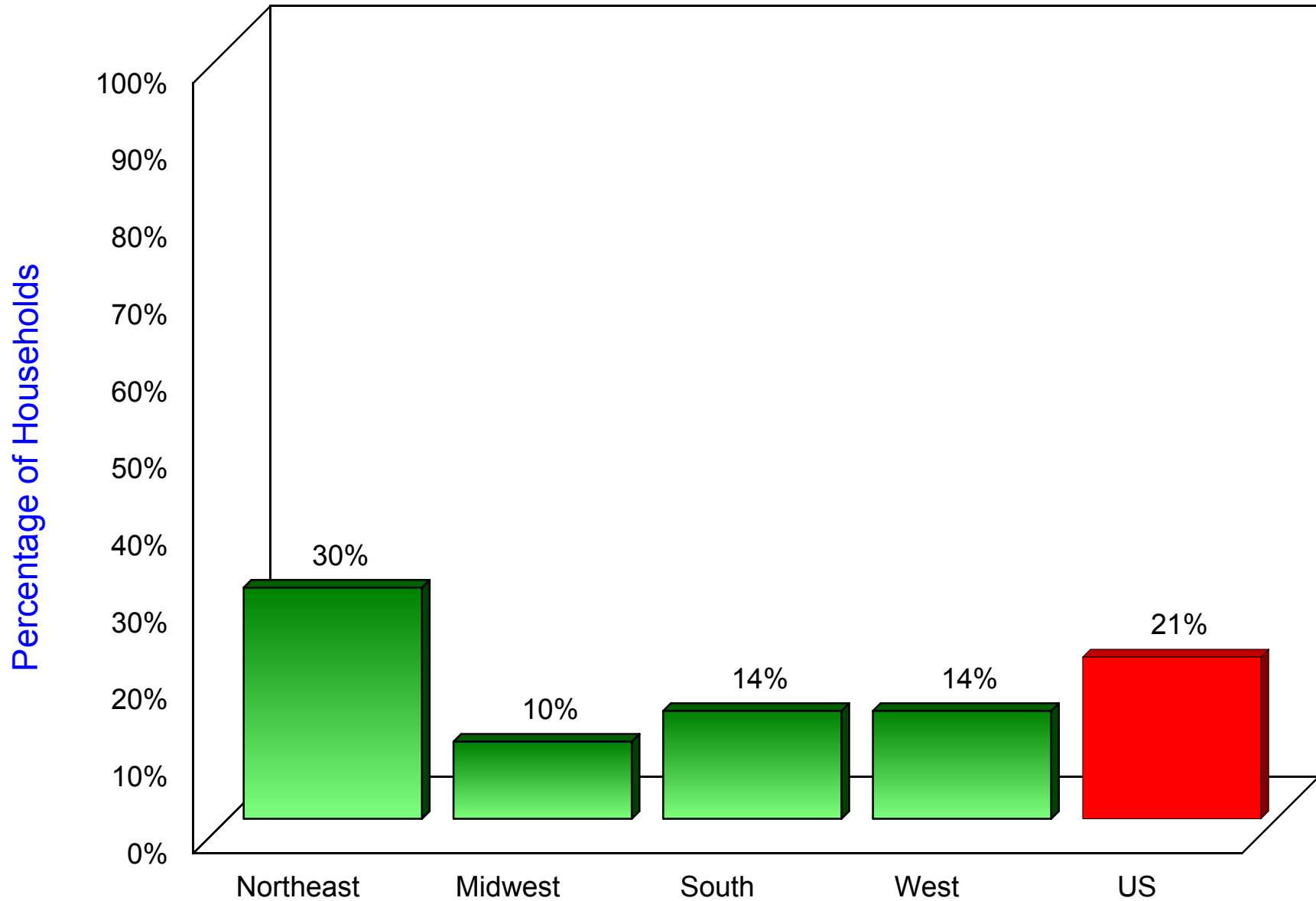

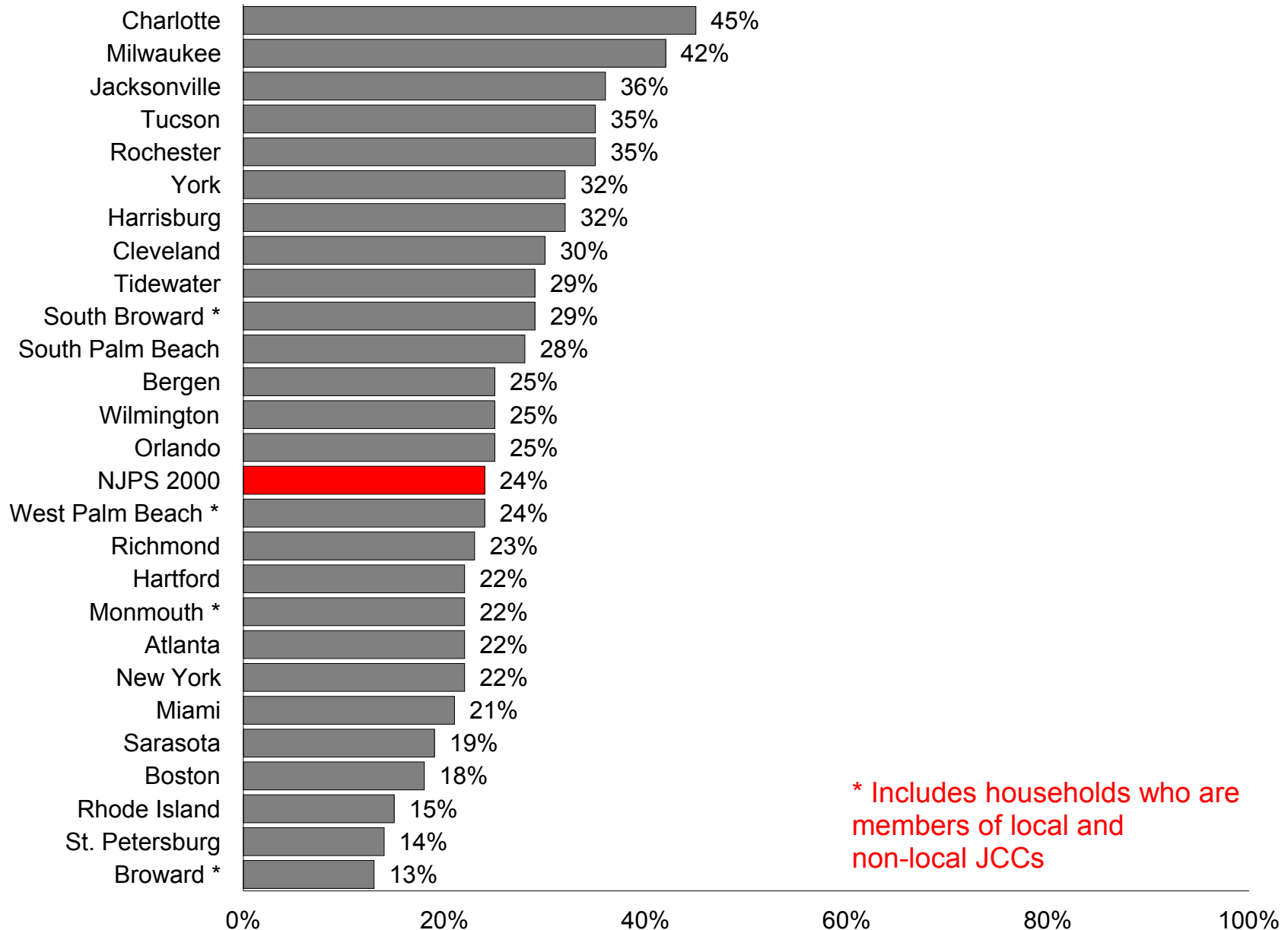


JCC MEMBERSHIP IN HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN

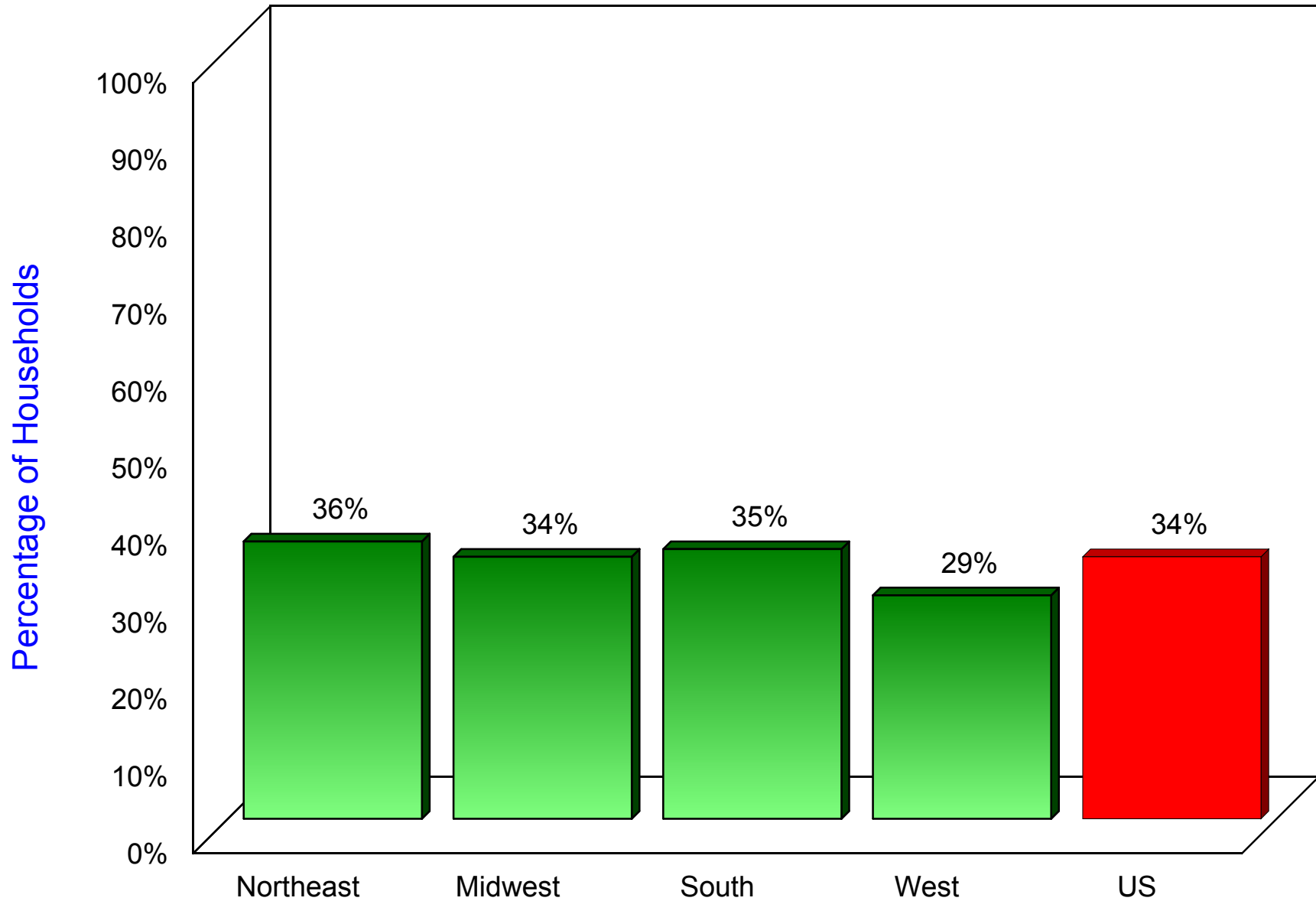

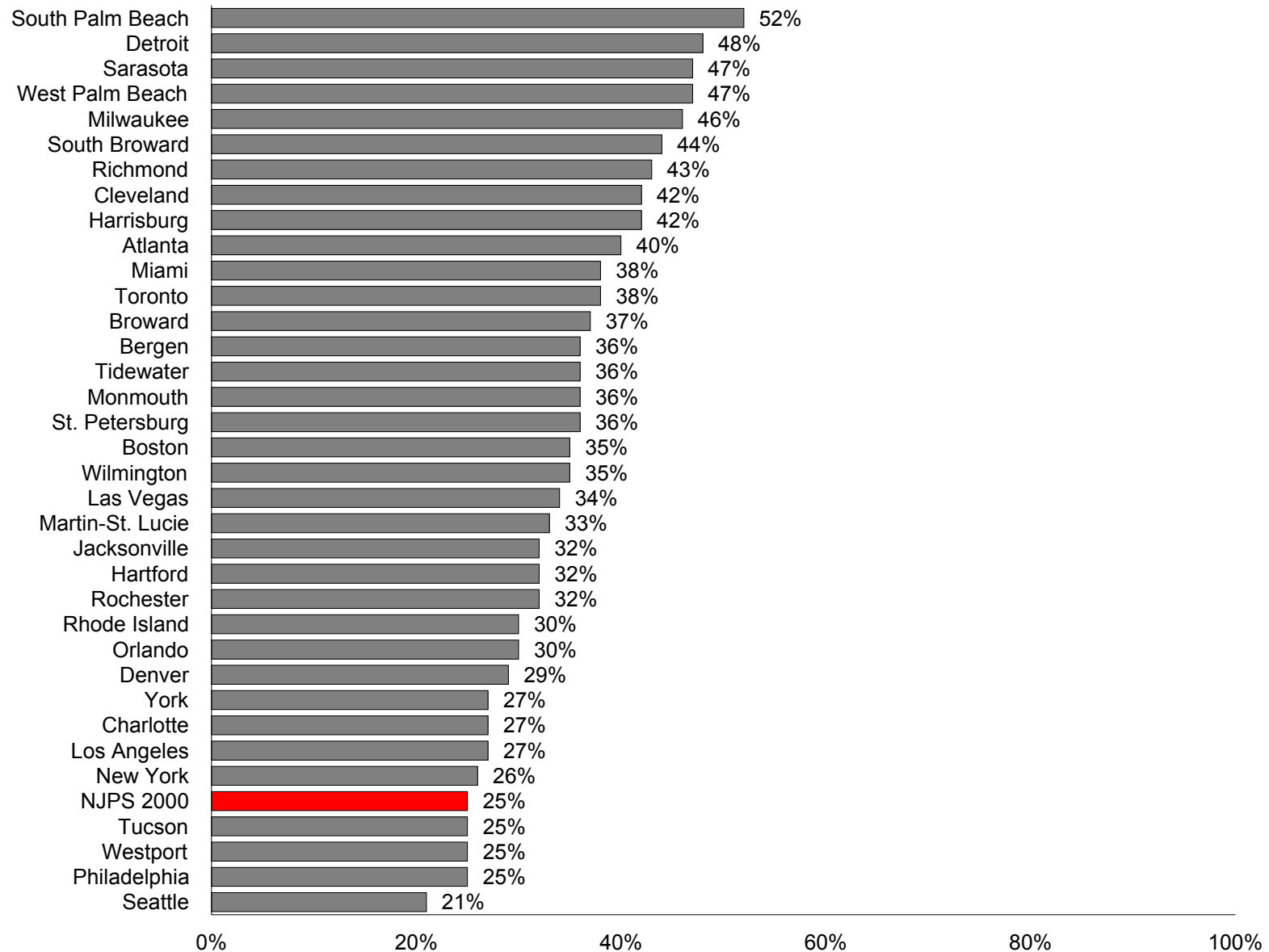


JEWISH ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP OTHER THAN A SYNAGOGUE OR JCC

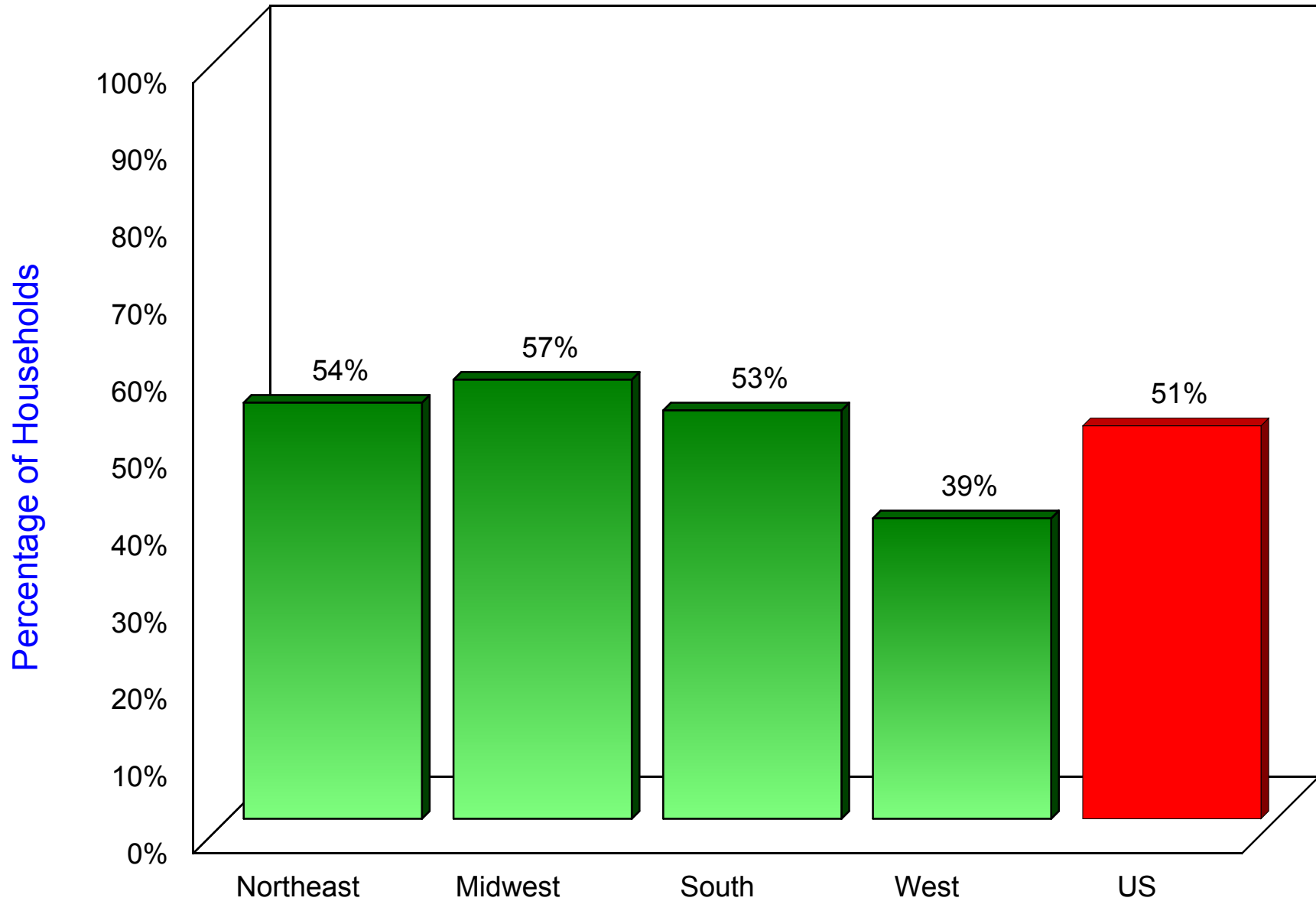

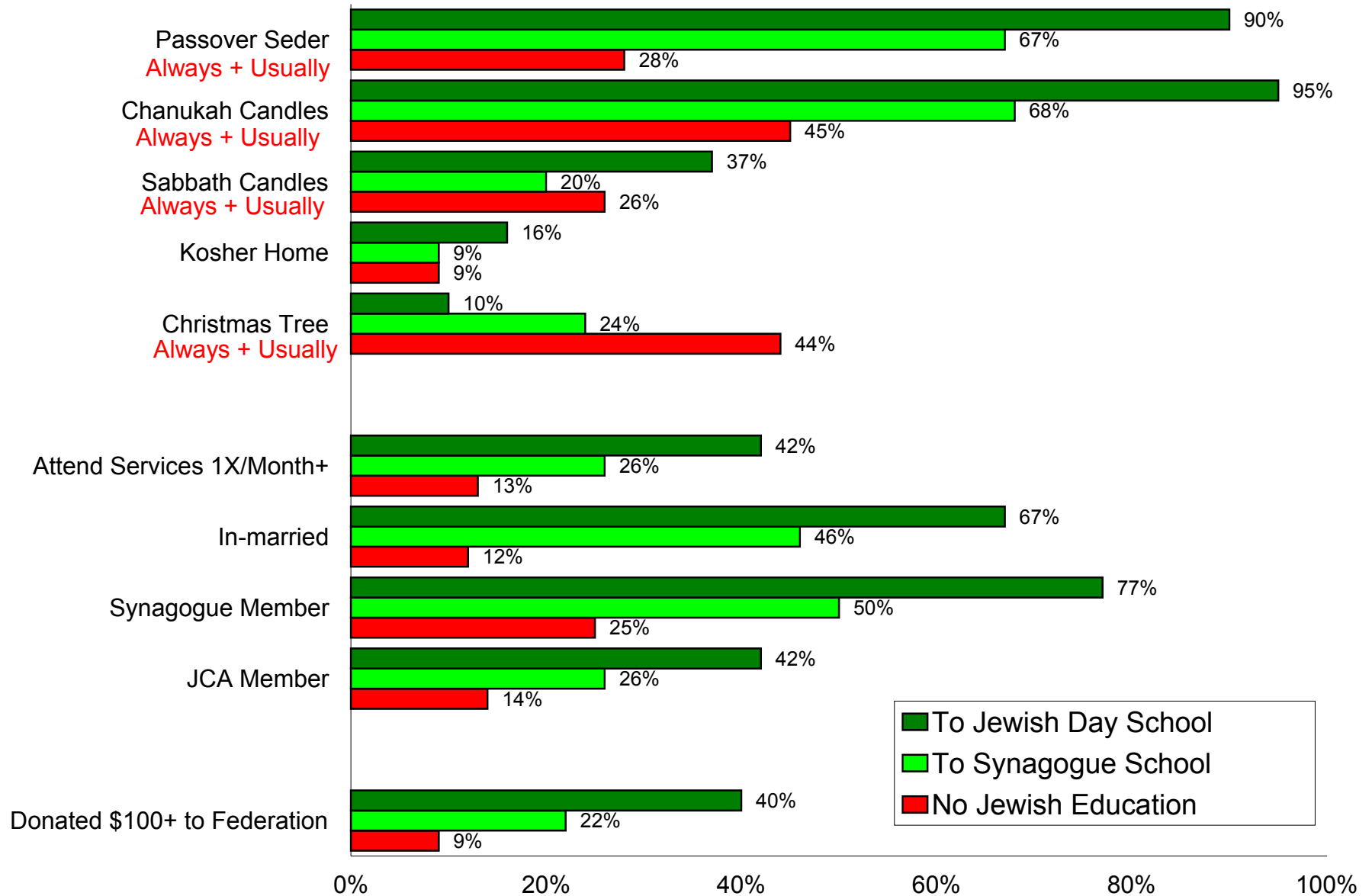

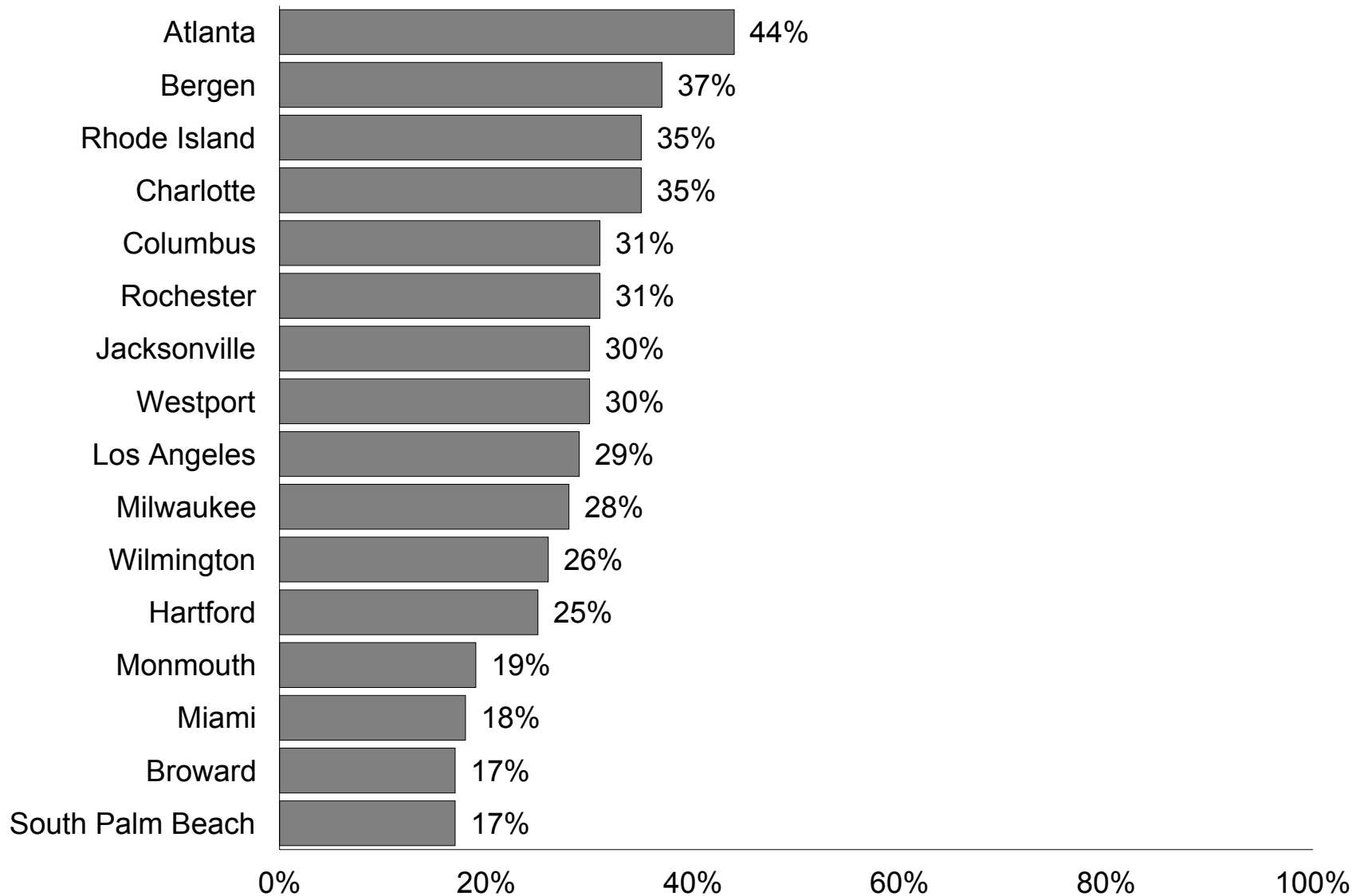

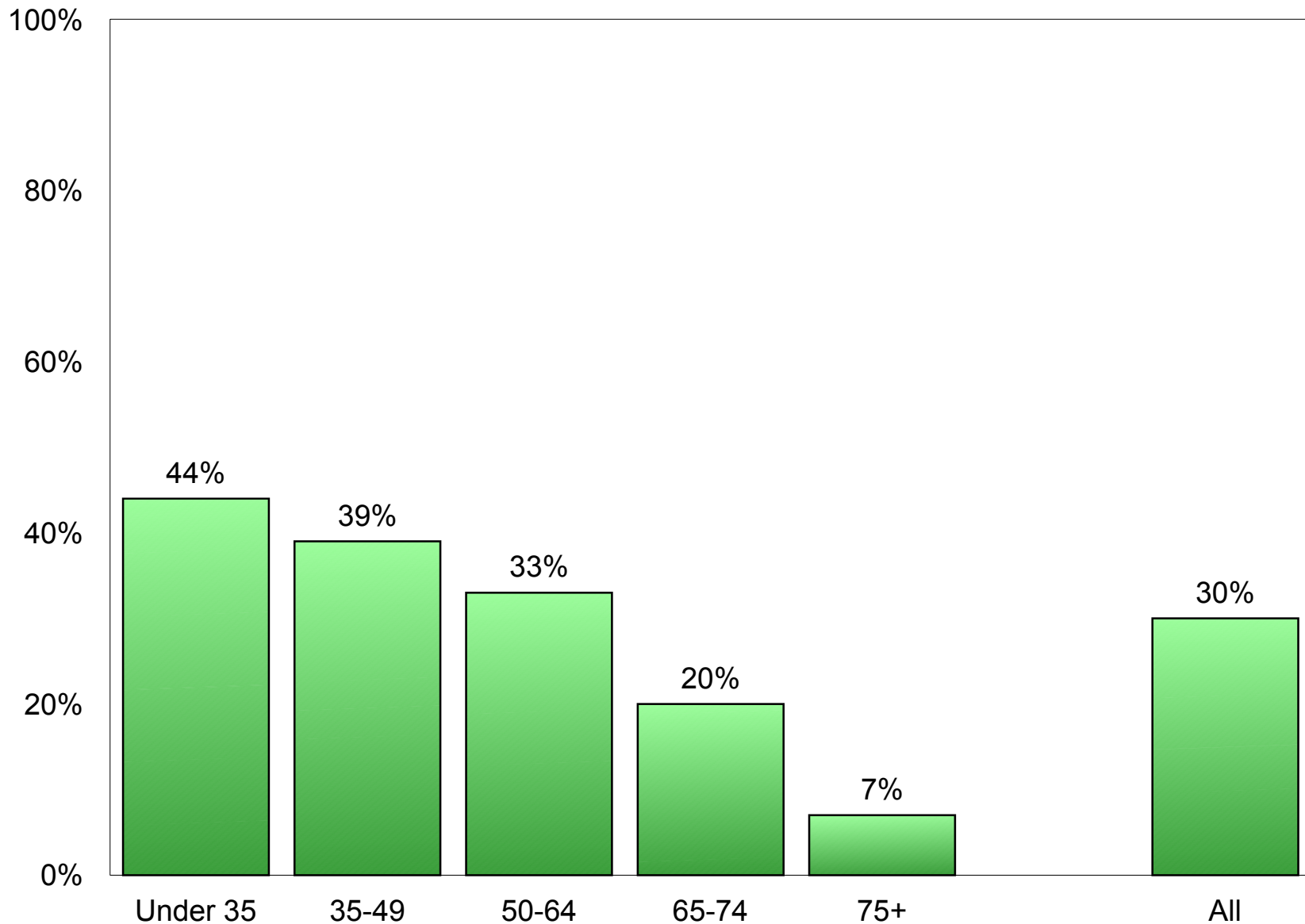


ATTENDED OR WORKED AT A JEWISH SLEEP AWAY CAMP AS A CHILD

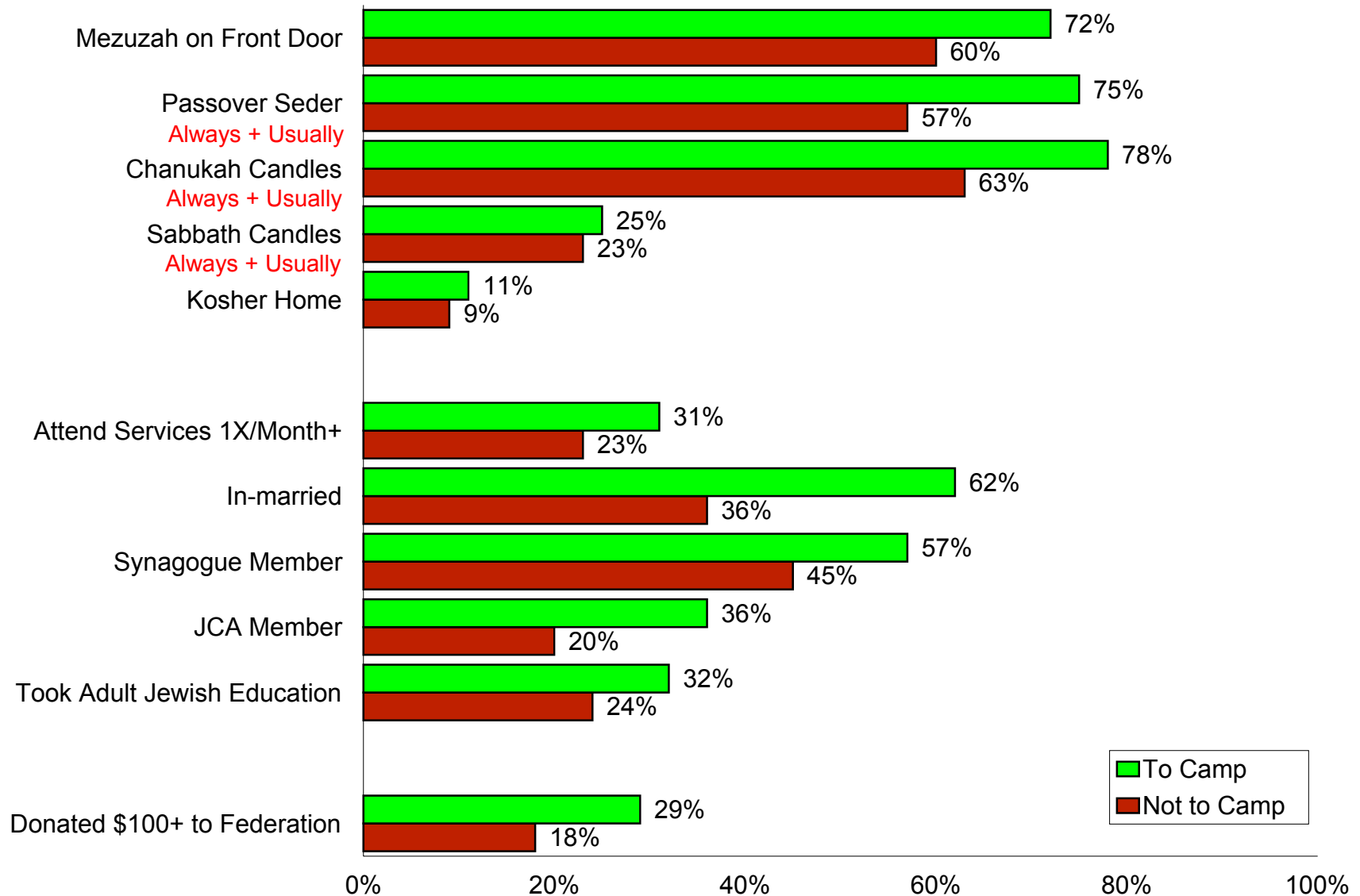

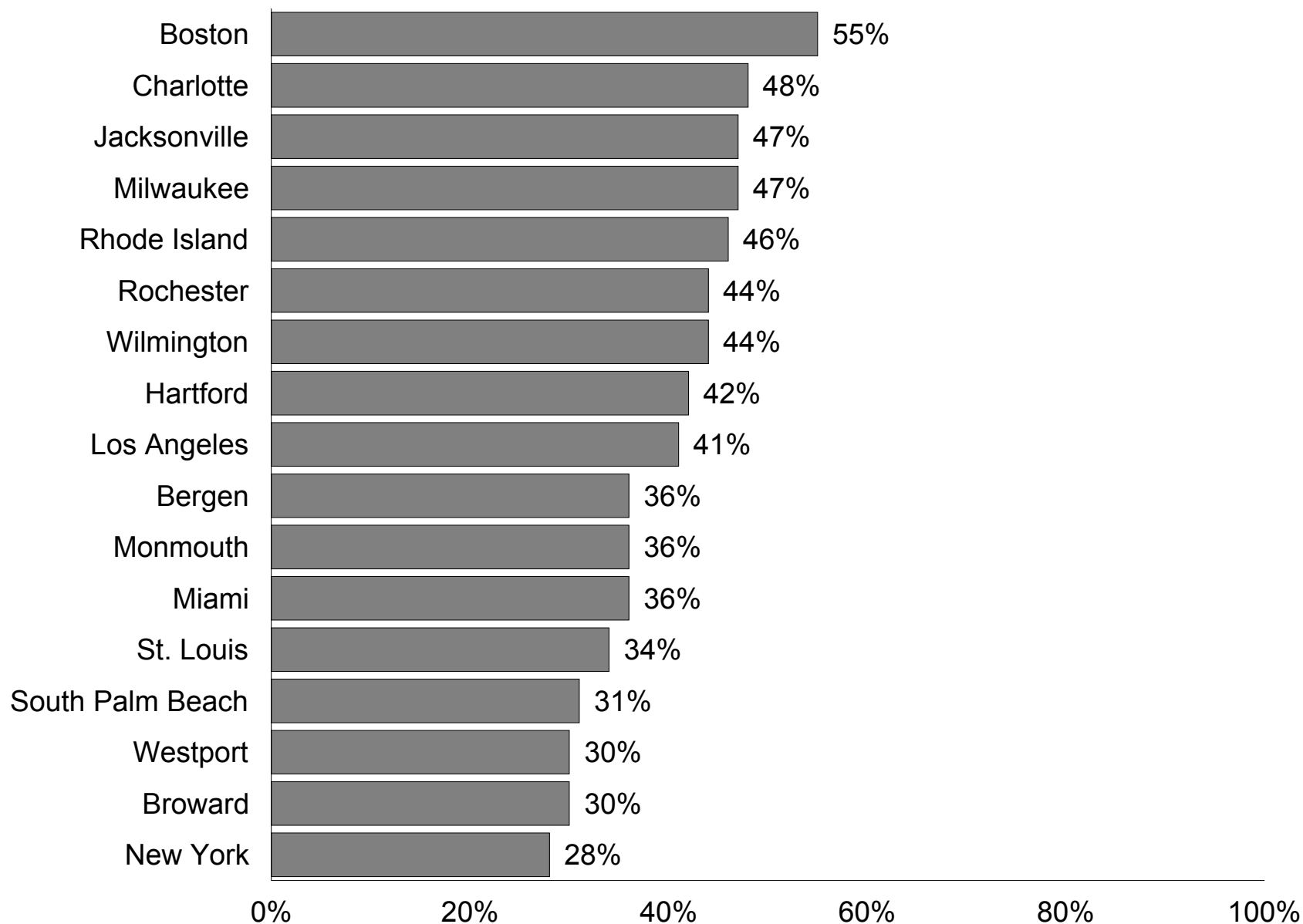

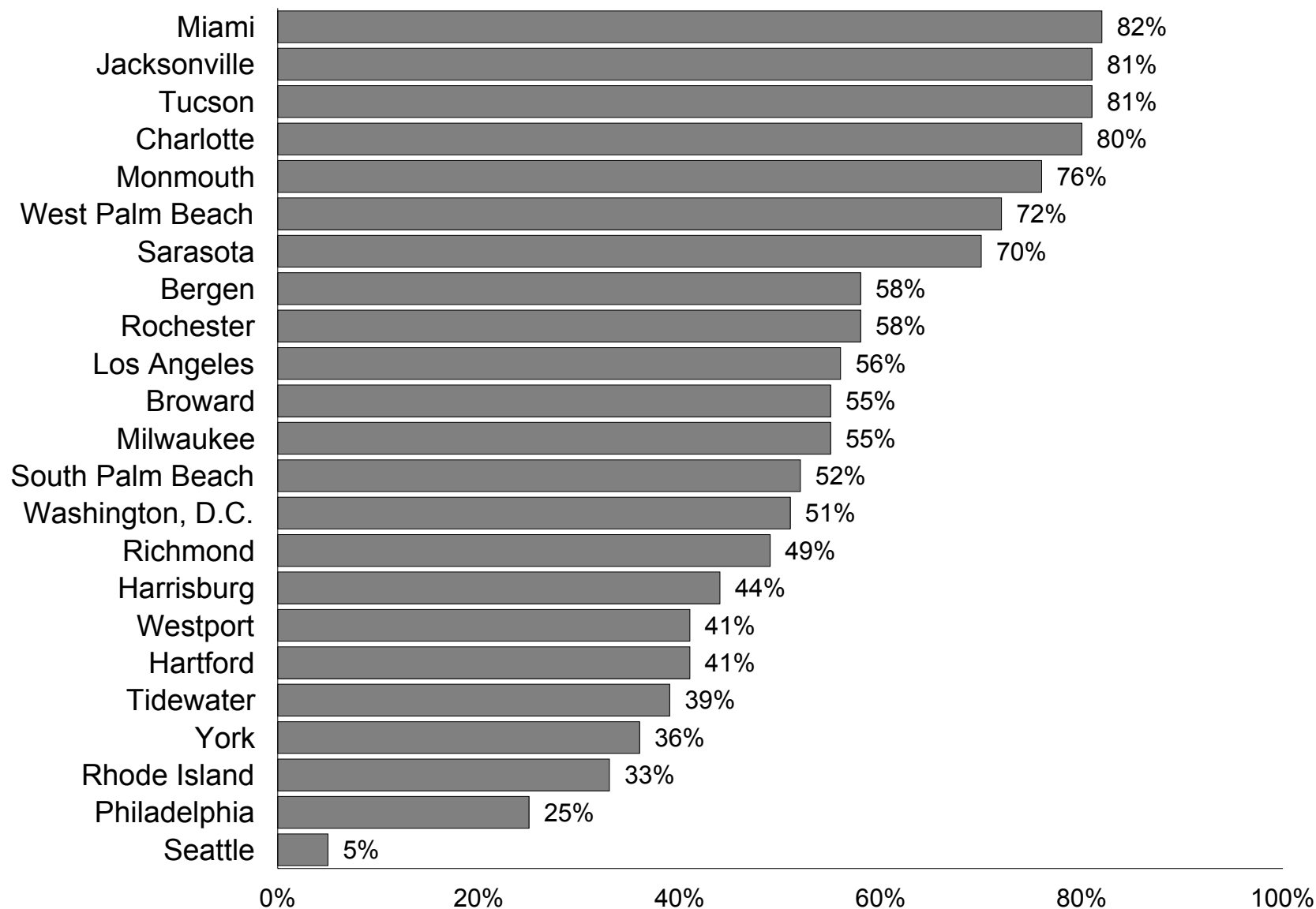


PRESCHOOL/CHILD CARE ENROLLMENT

(Jewish Children Age 0-5)

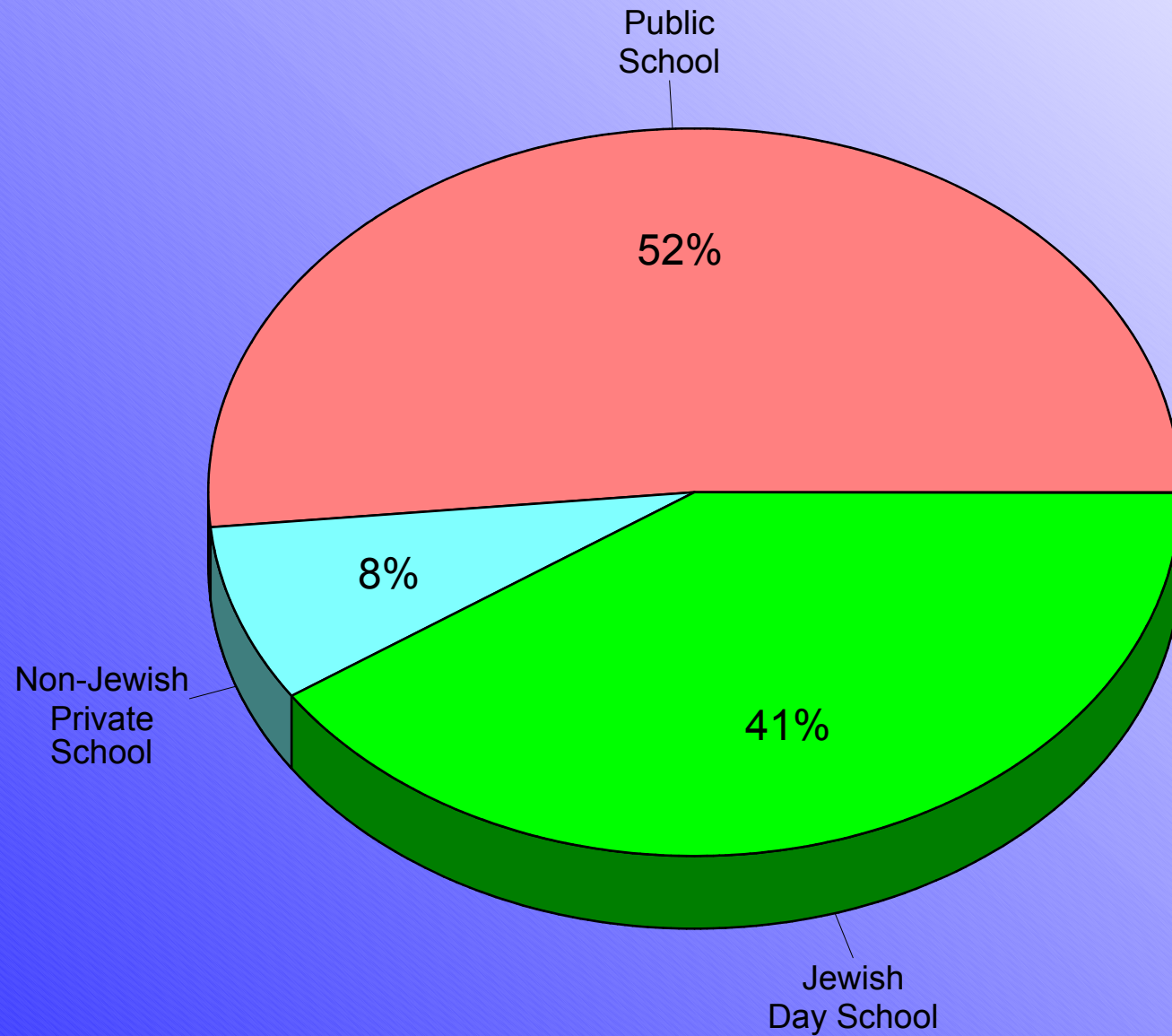


MARKET SHARE FOR JEWISH PRESCHOOL/CHILD CARE

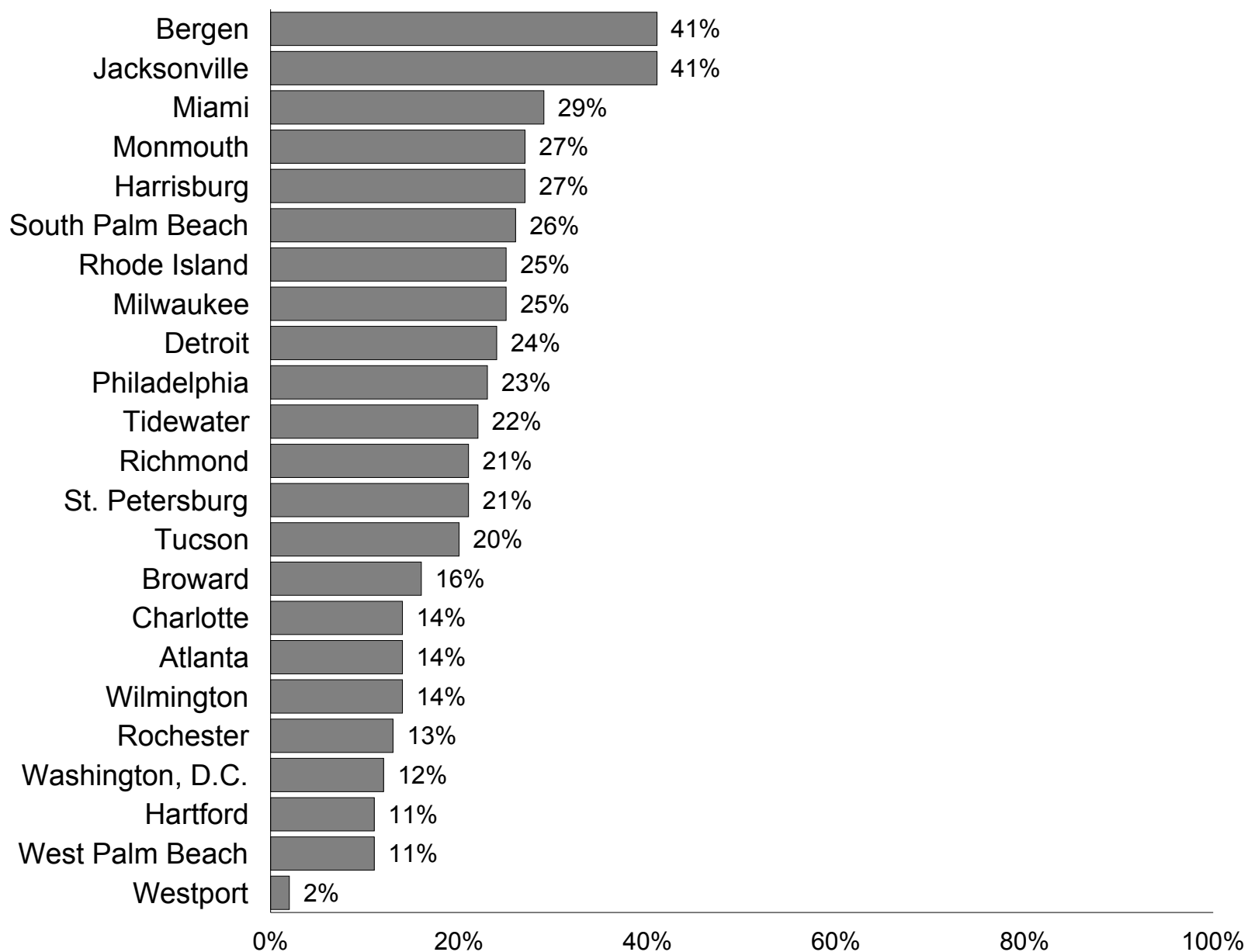

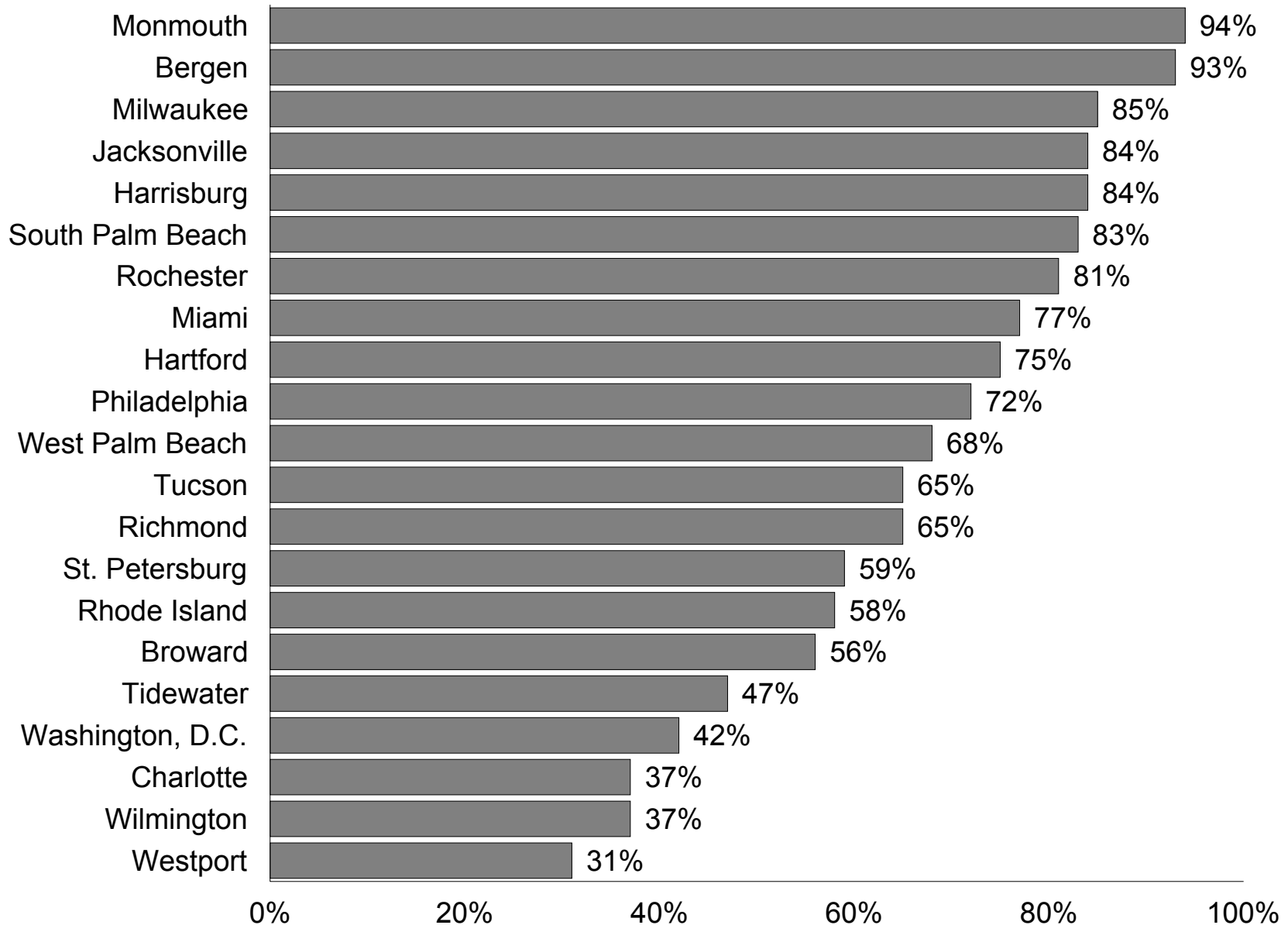

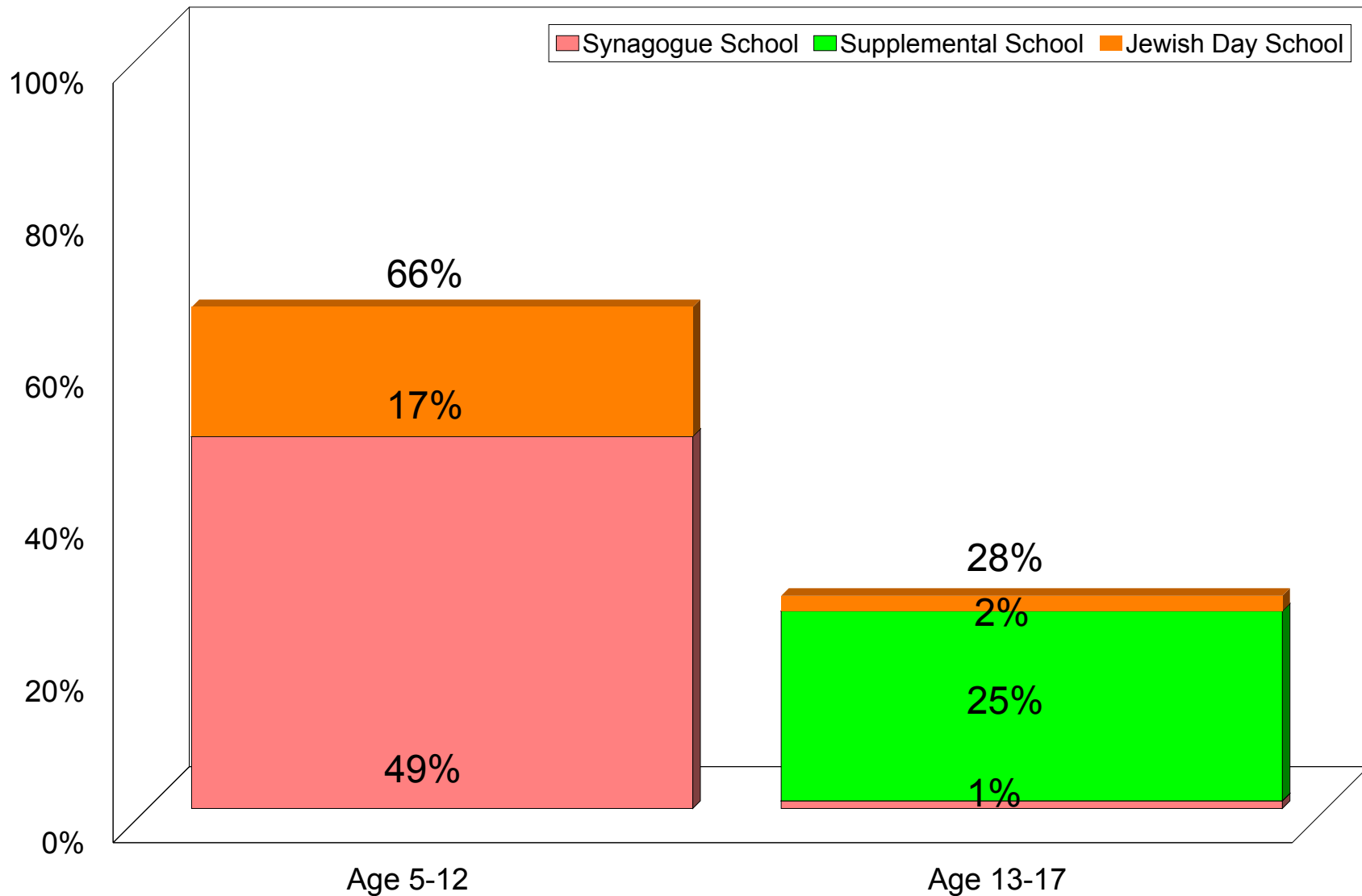

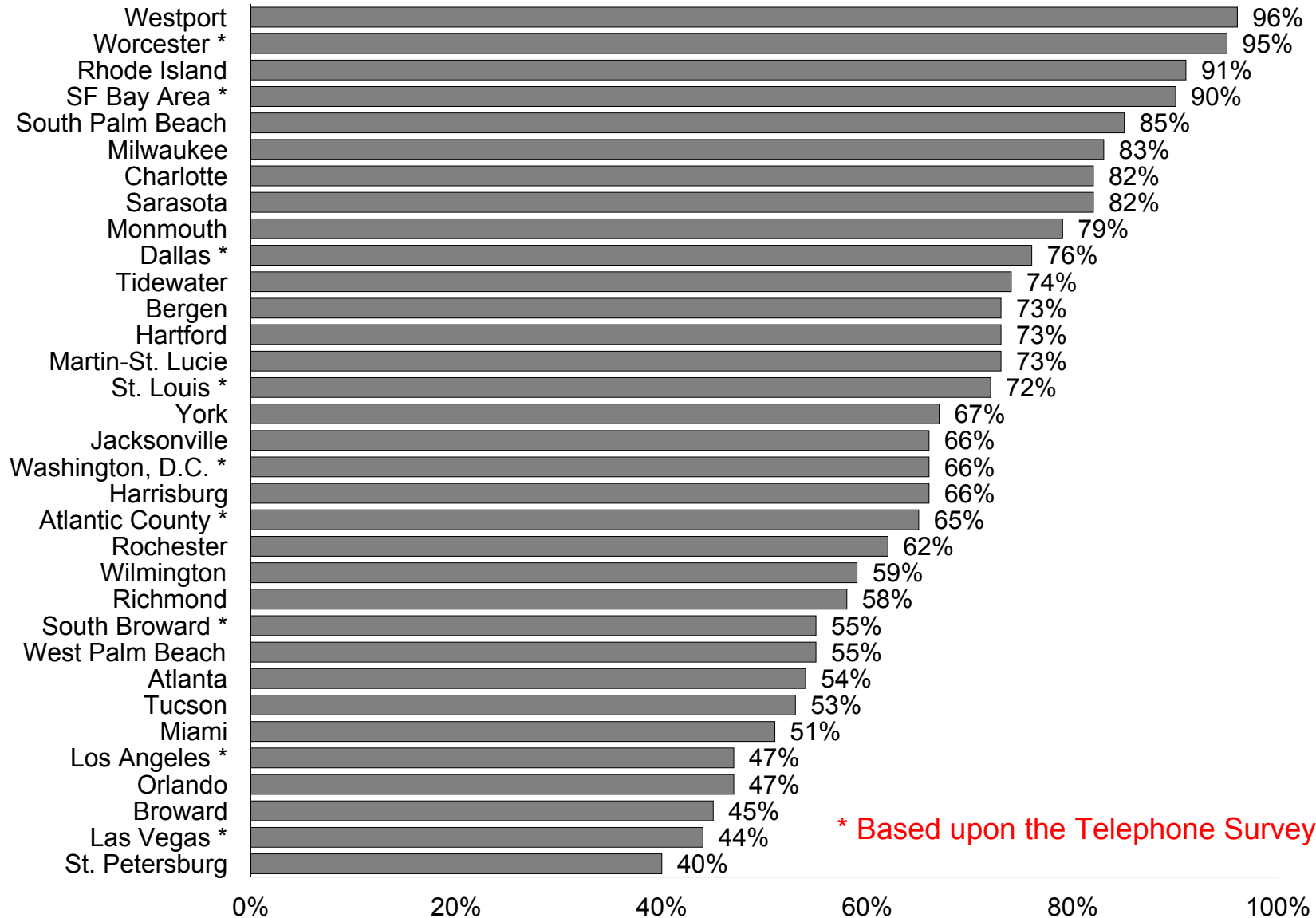
CURRENT ENROLLMENT OF JEWISH CHILDREN IN FORMAL JEWISH EDUCATION

JEWISH CHILDREN AGE 5-12 CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN FORMAL JEWISH EDUCATION

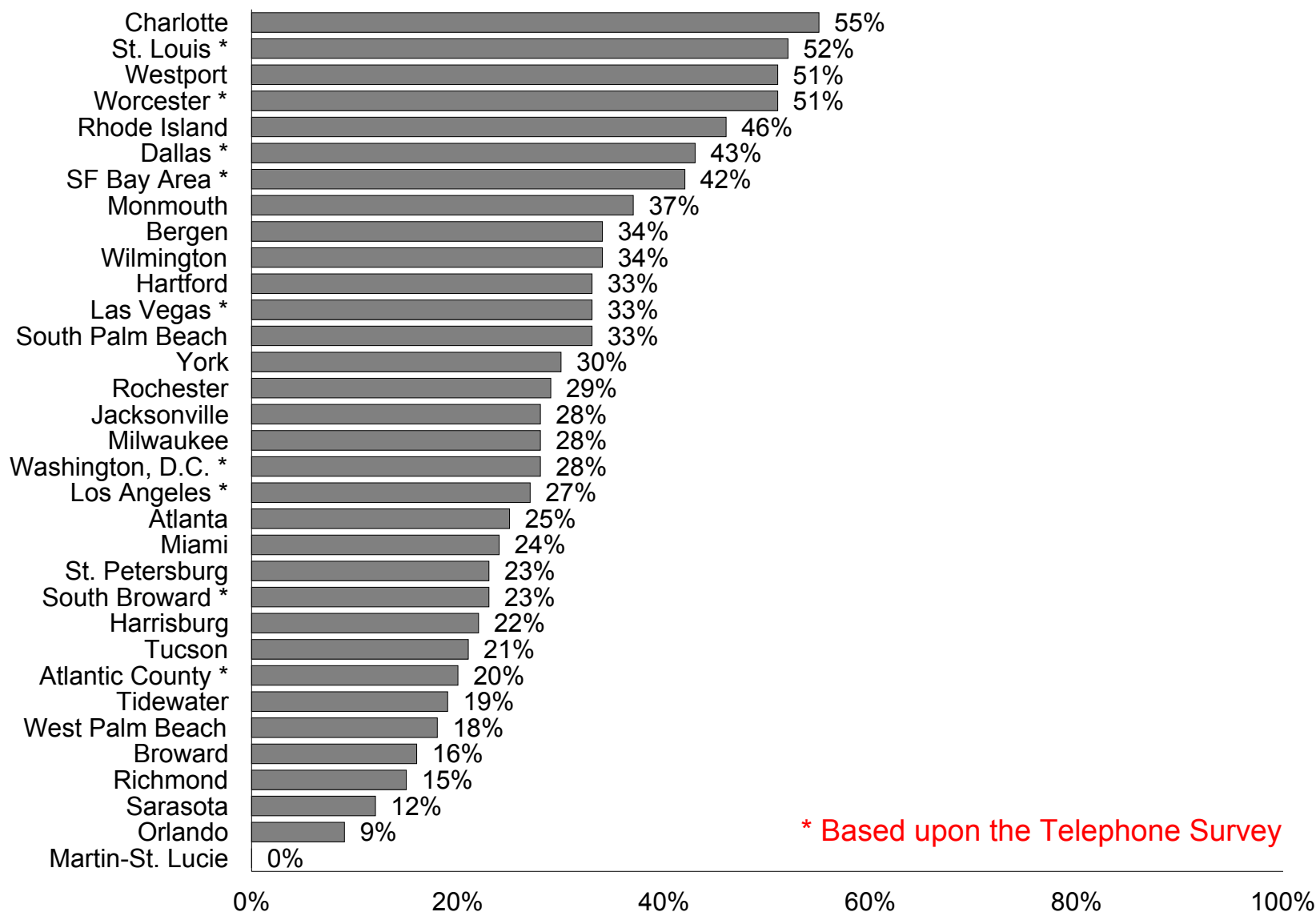

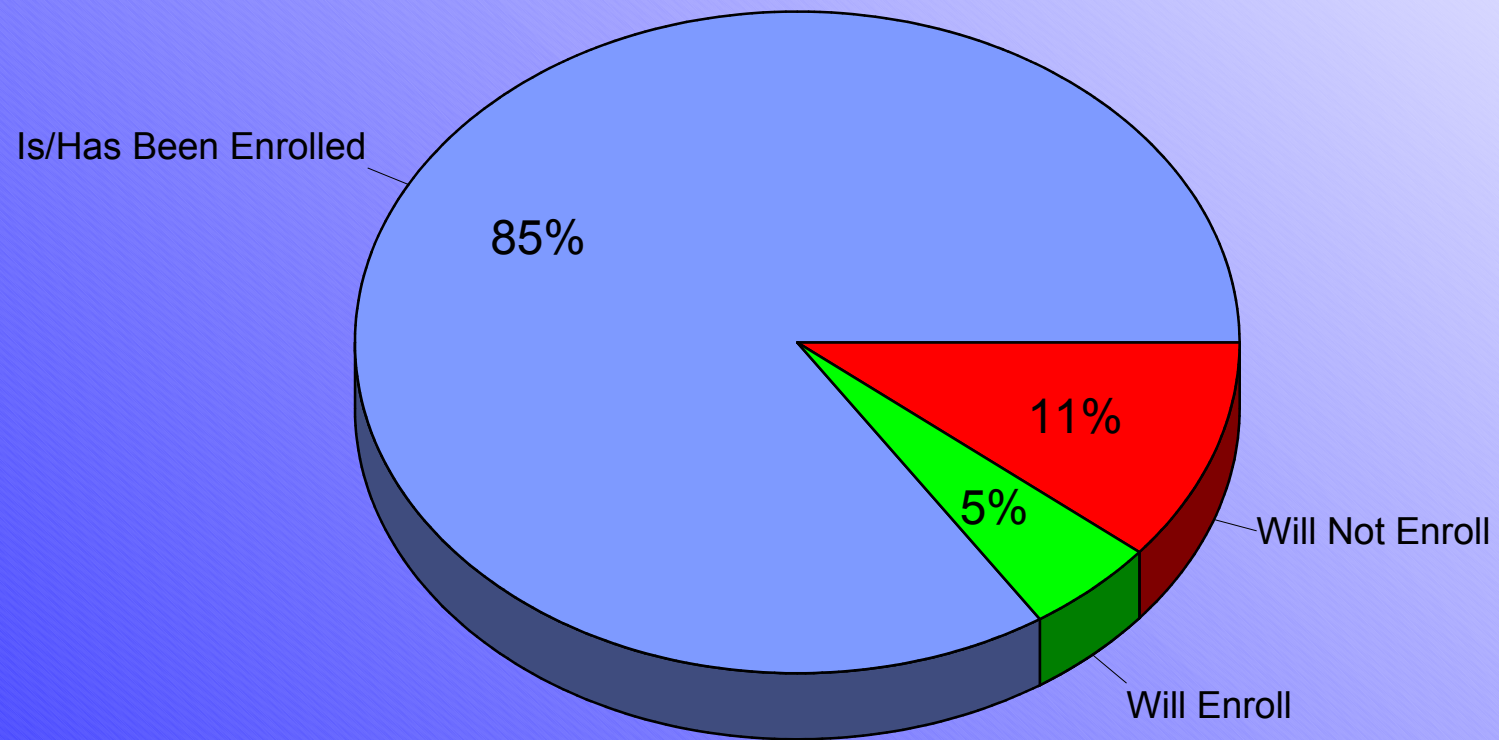

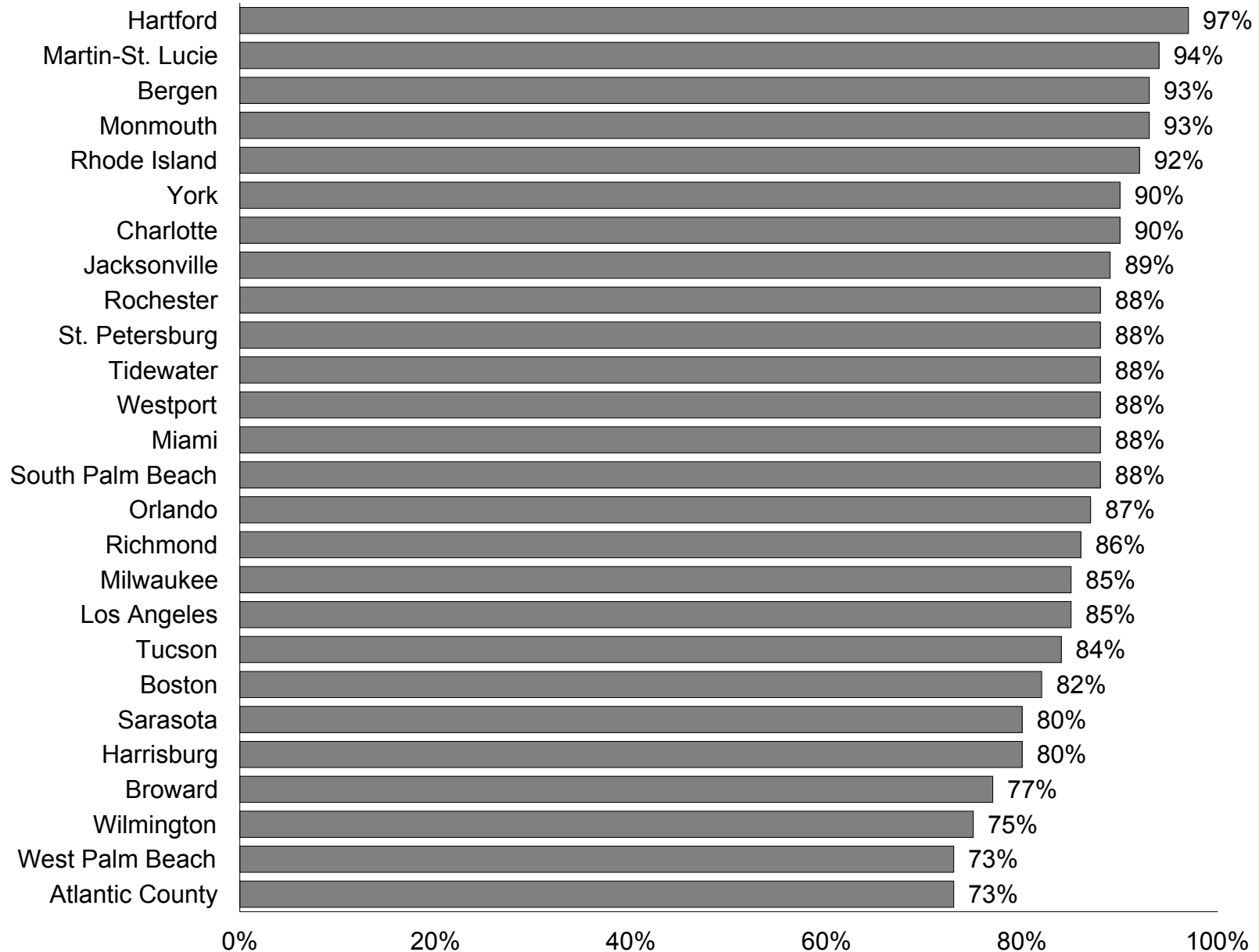


RECEIPT OF SOME FORMAL JEWISH EDUCATION

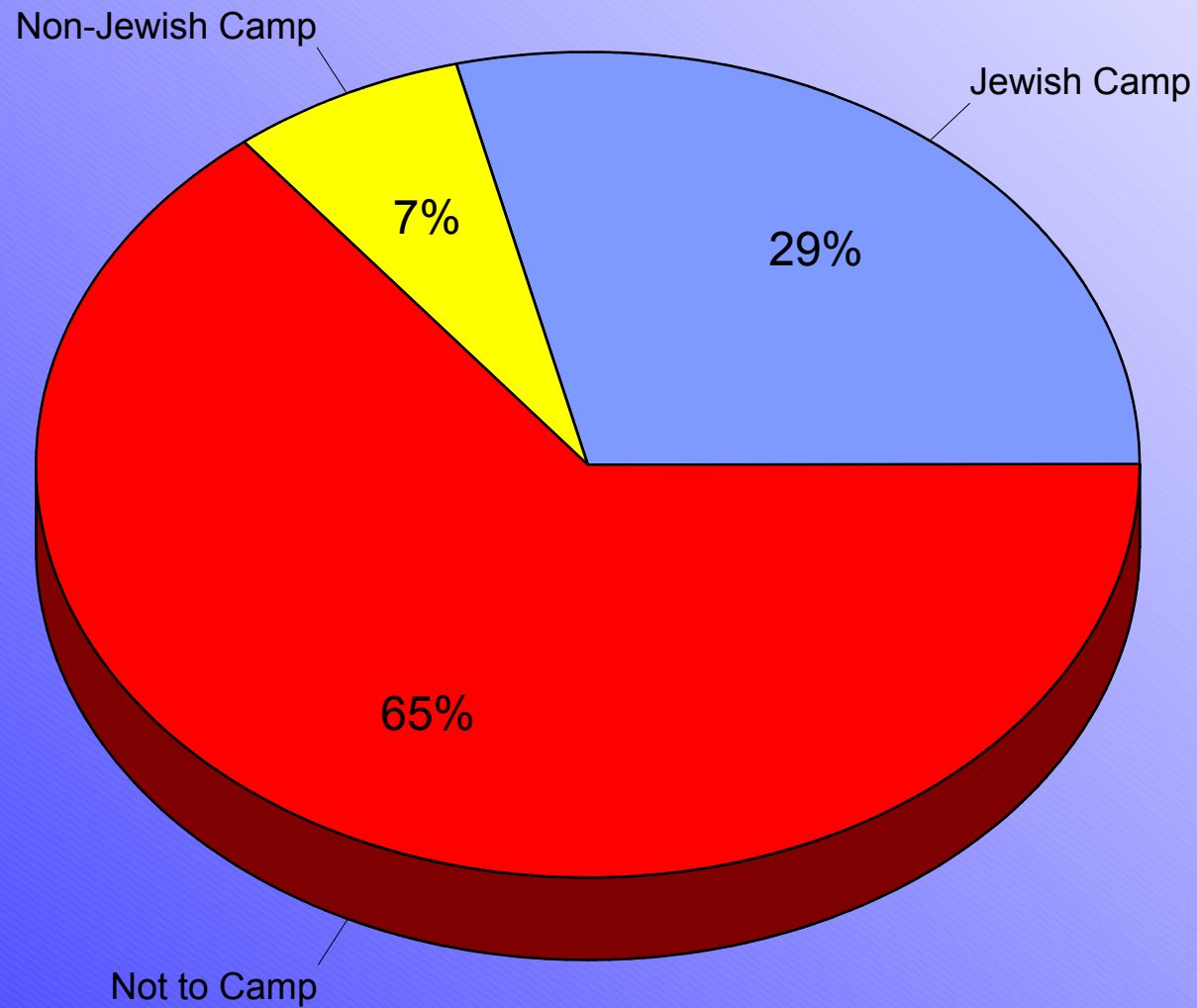


CONDITIONS PREVENTING JEWISH CHILDREN FROM RECEIVING A JEWISH EDUCATION

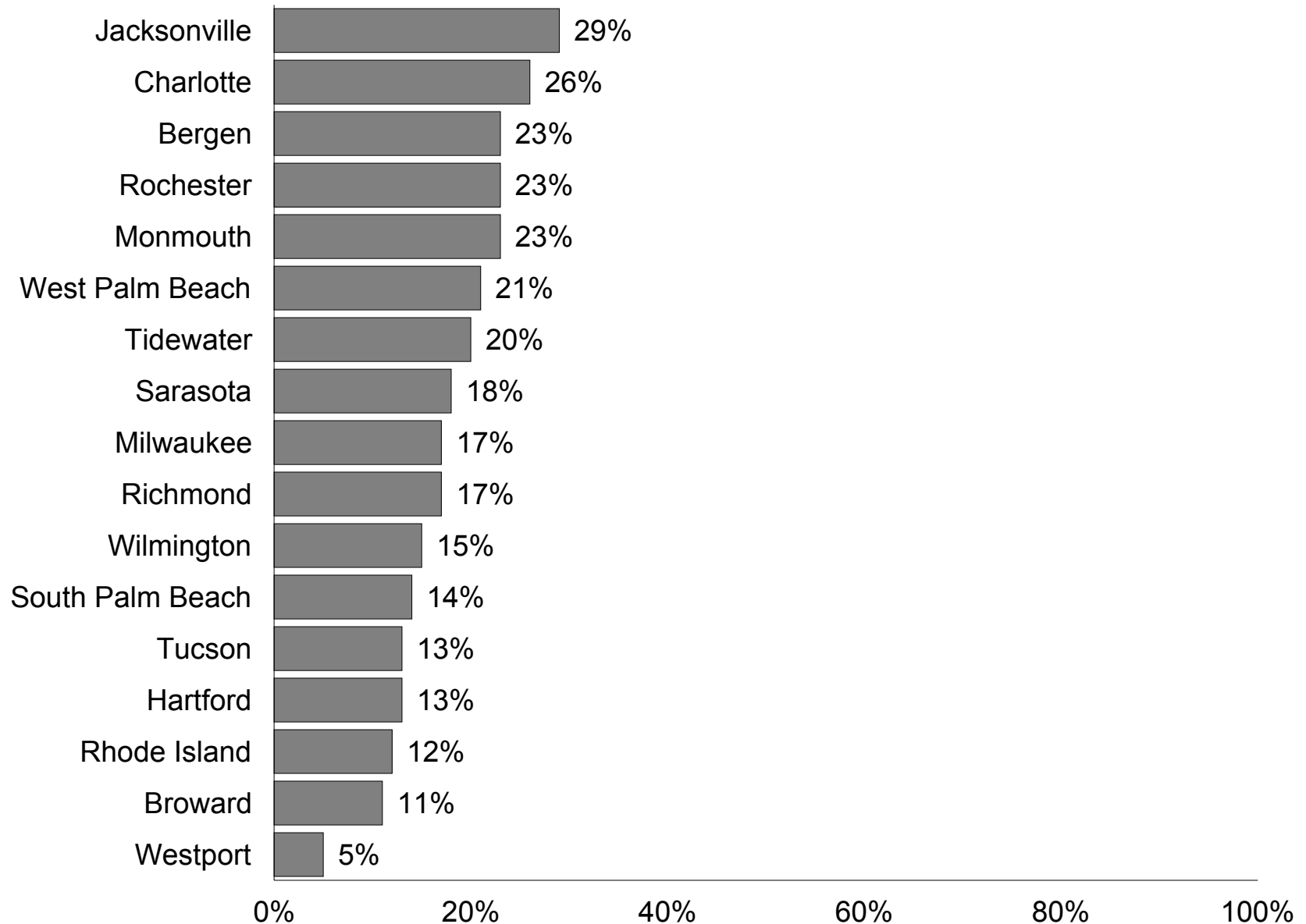
- 5.8% (83 households) of households with Jewish children age 0-17 have children with a learning disability or other special needs that has prevented them from receiving a Jewish education
- 2.2% (32 households) of households with Jewish children age 0-17 have children with a health condition that has prevented them from receiving a Jewish education
- In total, due to the overlap between the above groups, 6.4% (92 households) with Jewish children age 0-17 have children with a learning disabilities or a health condition that has prevented them from receiving a Jewish education

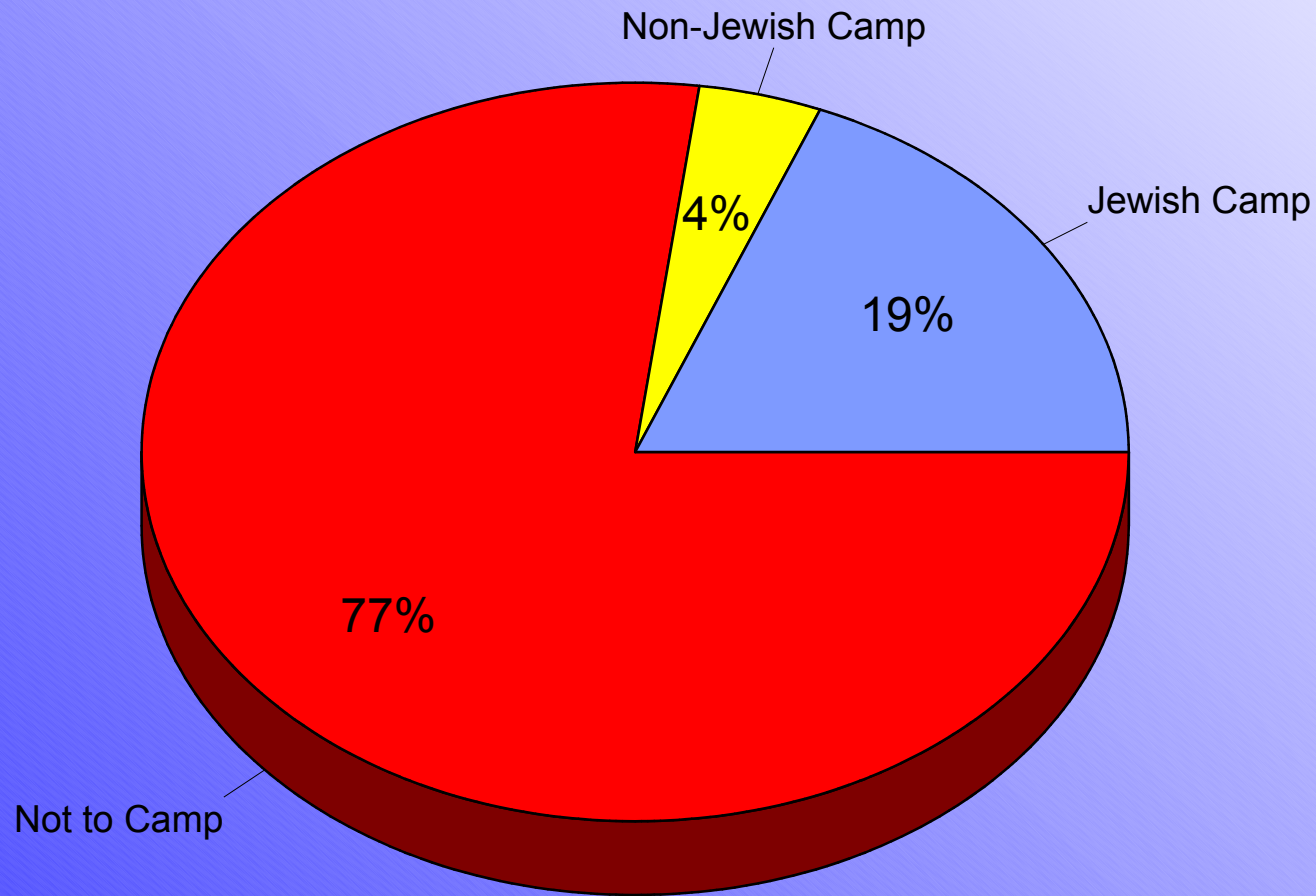

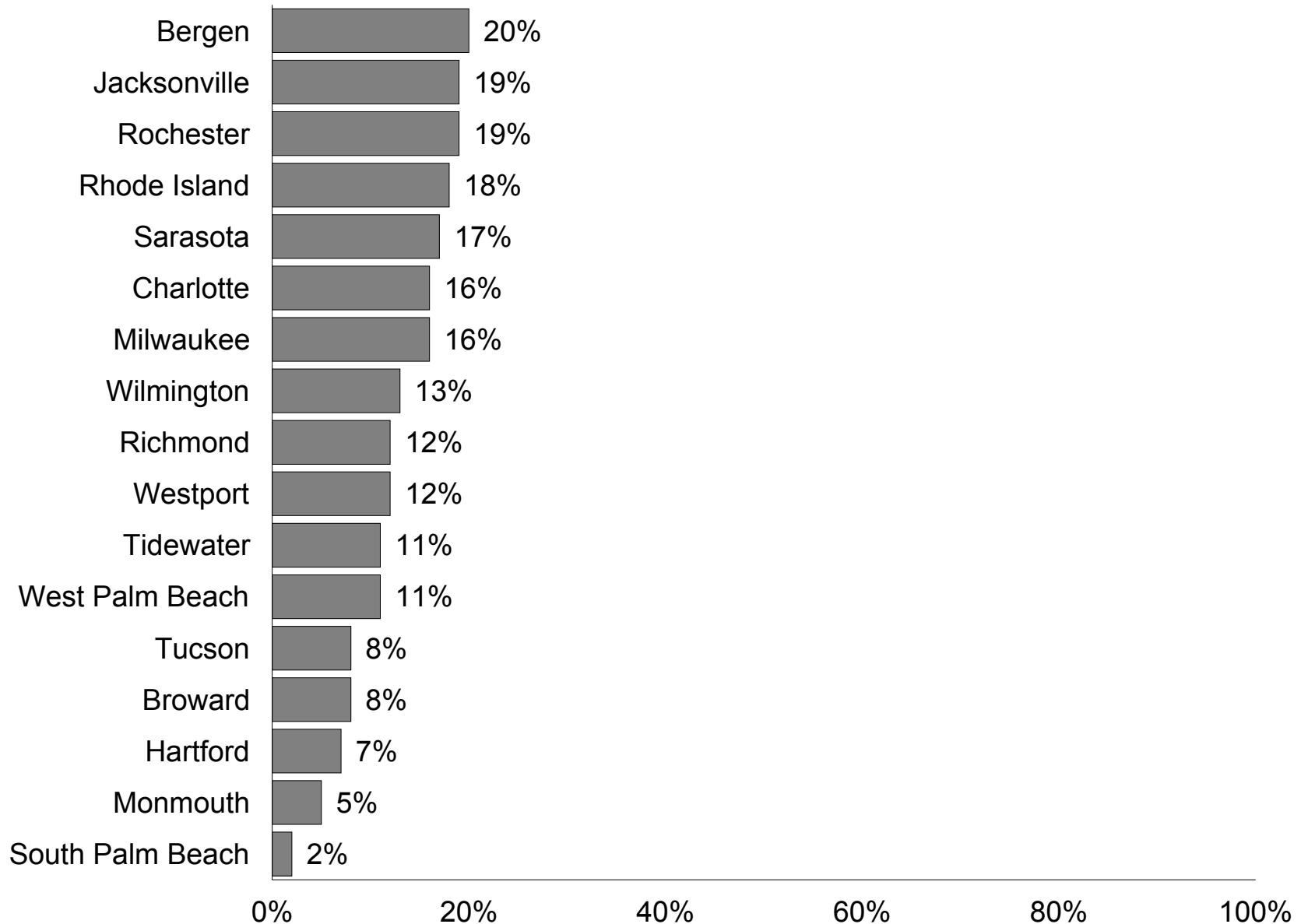

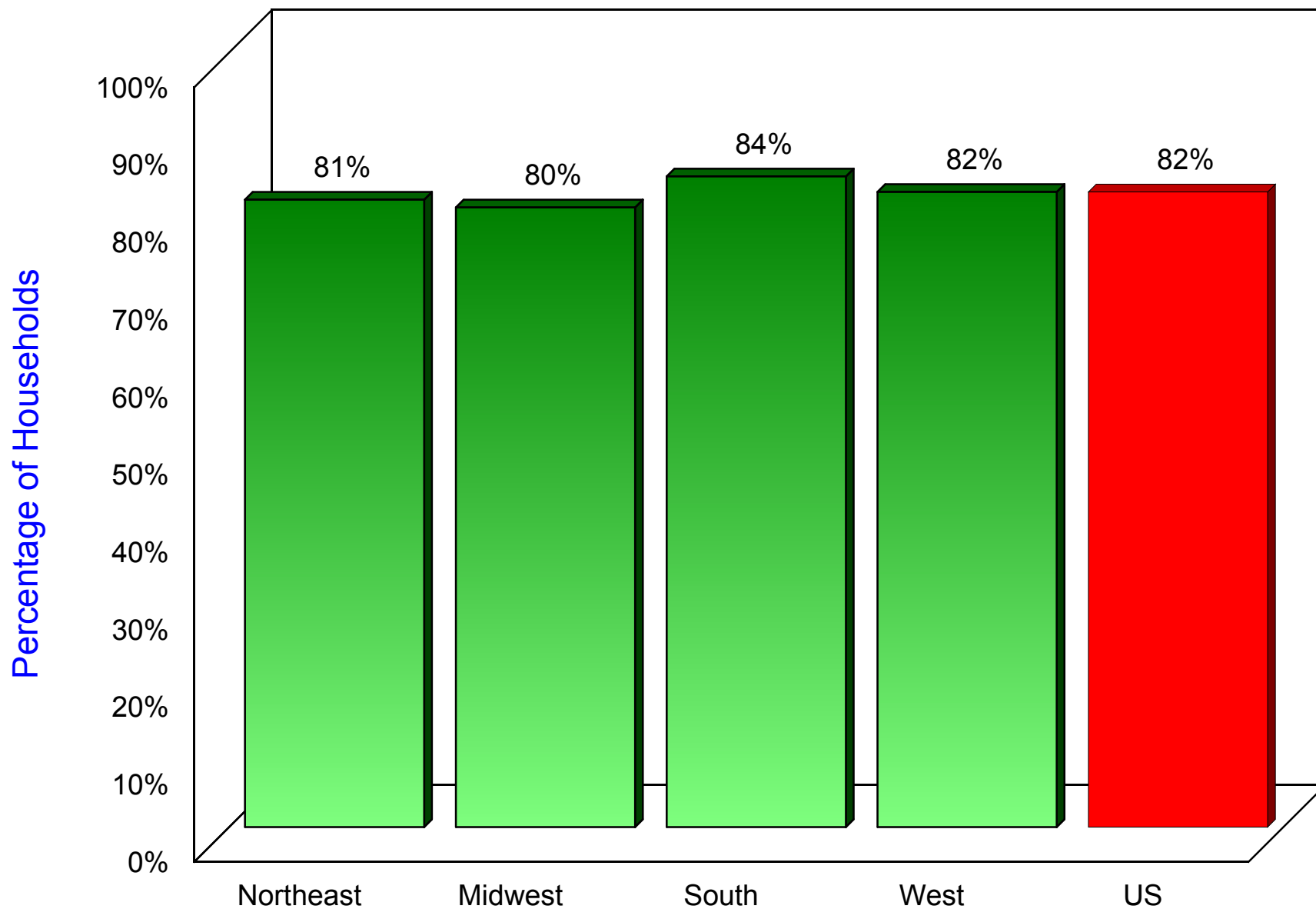


PERCEPTION OF ANTI-SEMITISM IN UNITED STATES

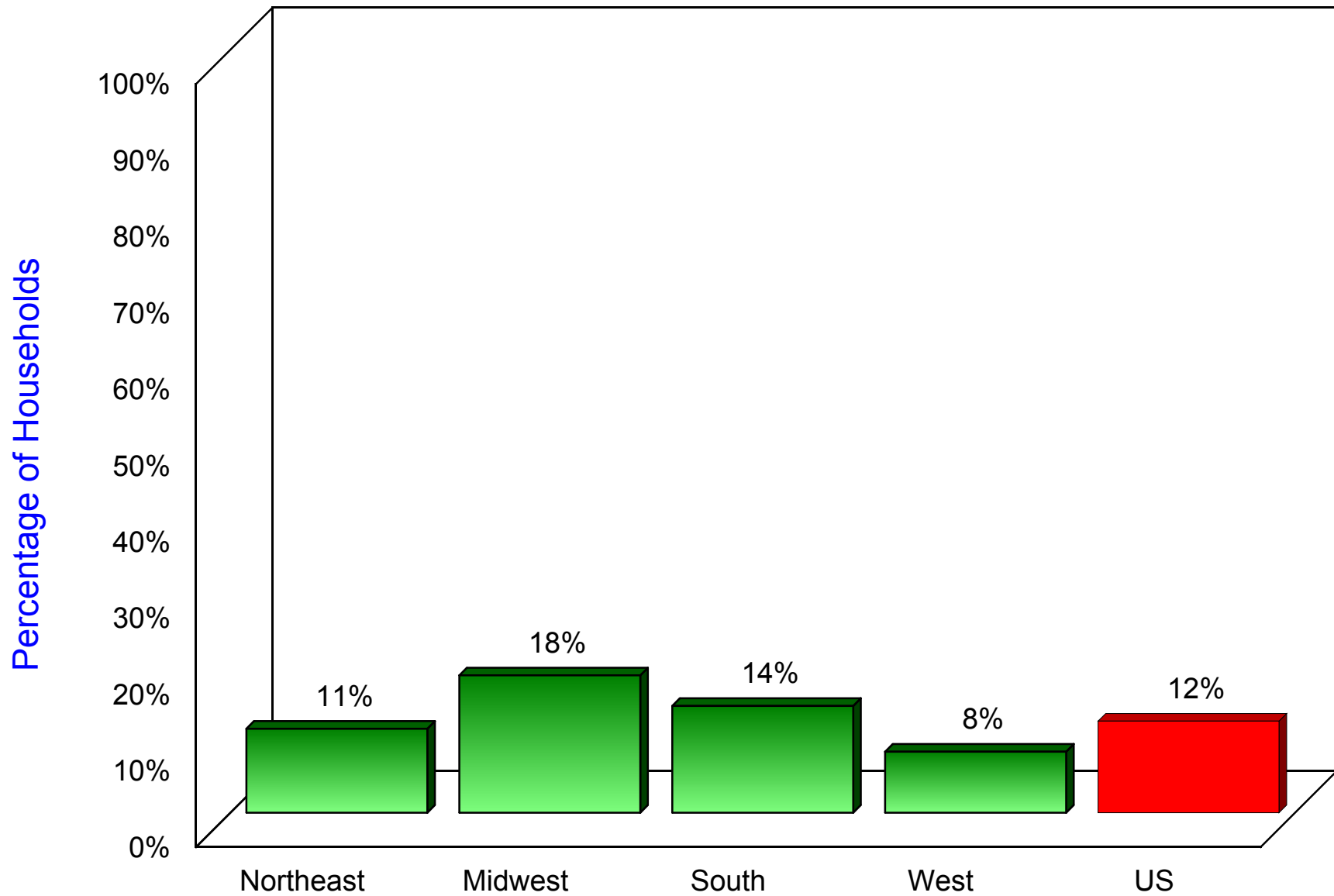

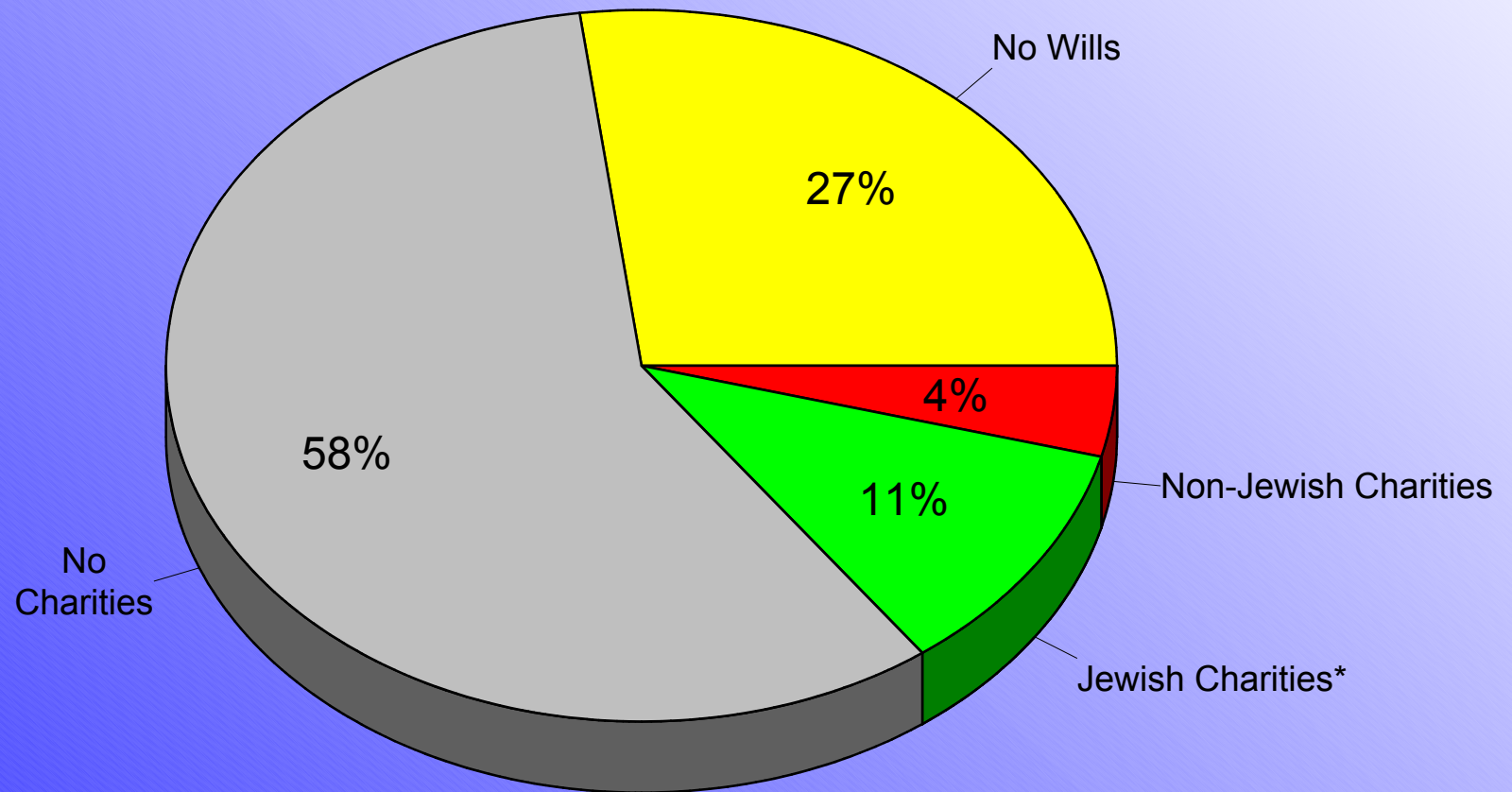

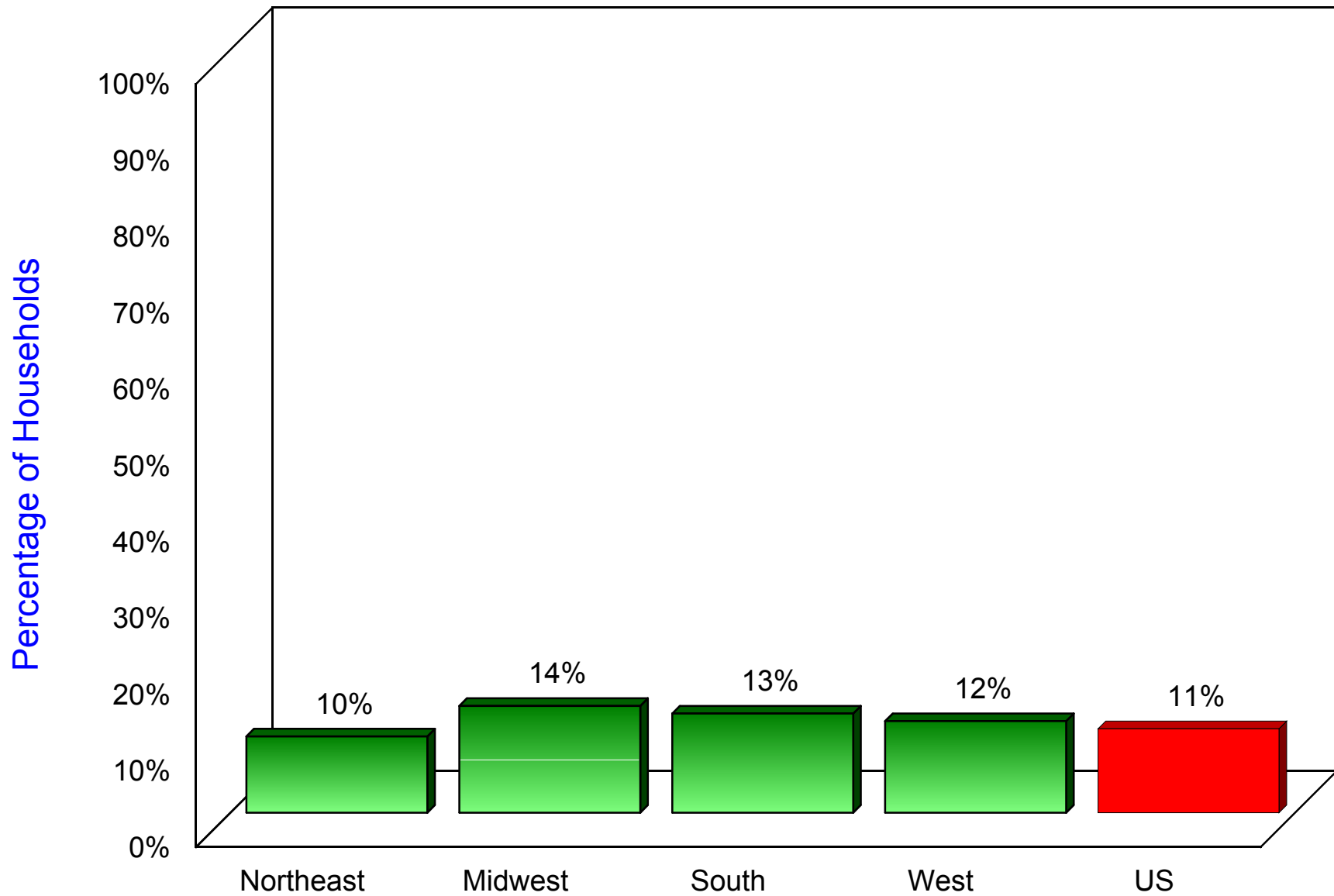


CHARITABLE PROVISIONS IN WILLS

(Respondents Age 50 and Over Only)

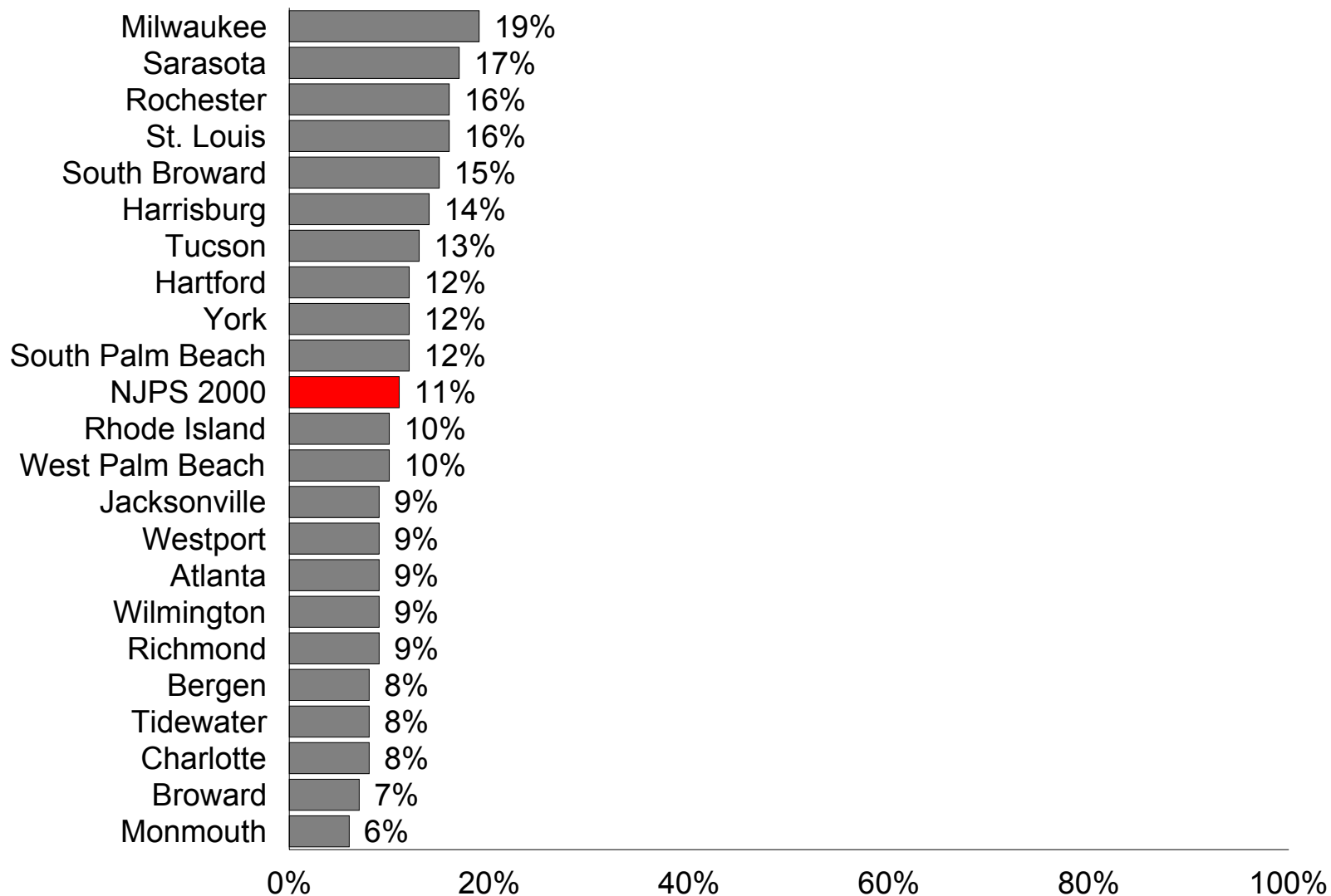


HAVE WILL WITH A PROVISION FOR A JEWISH CHARITY

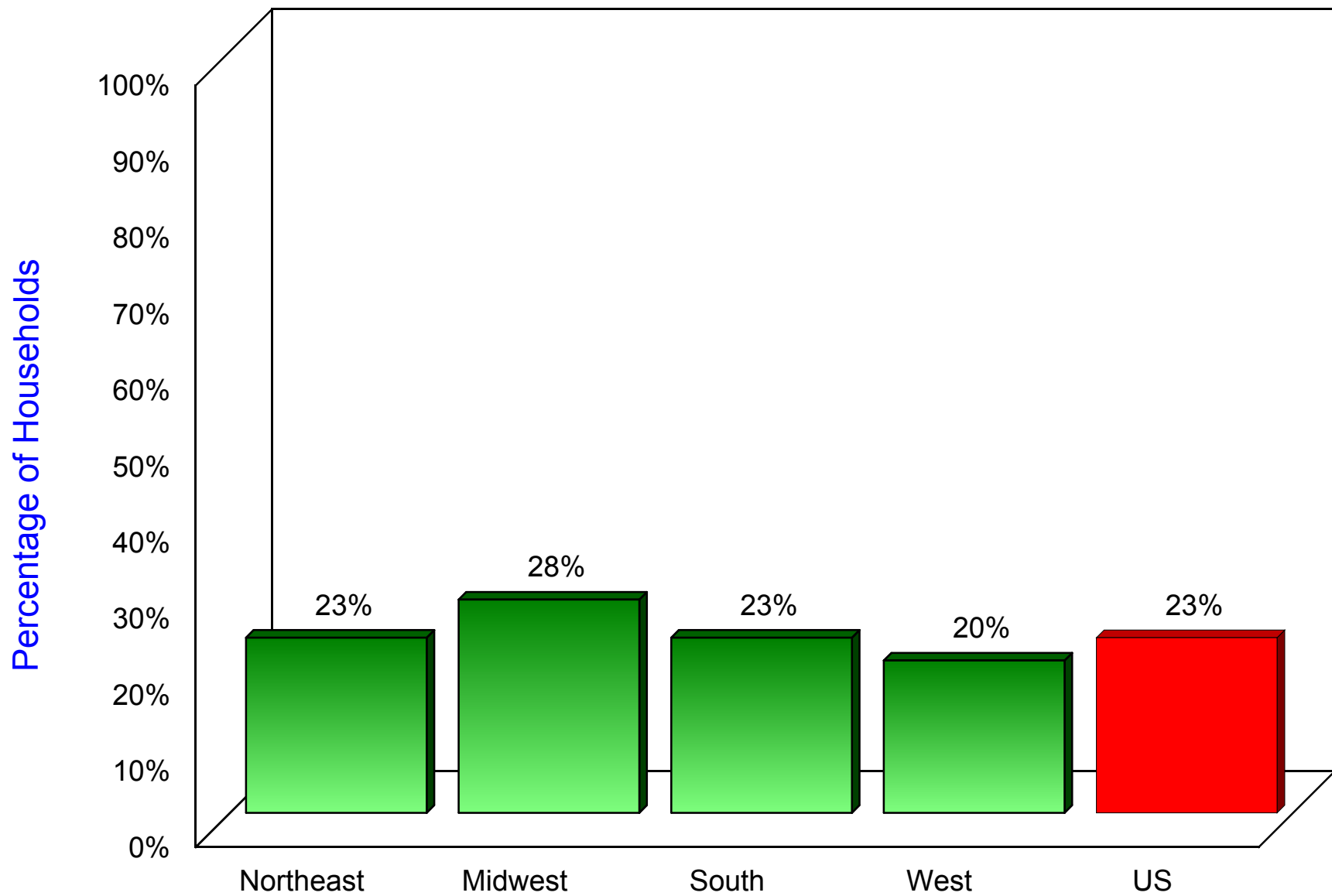

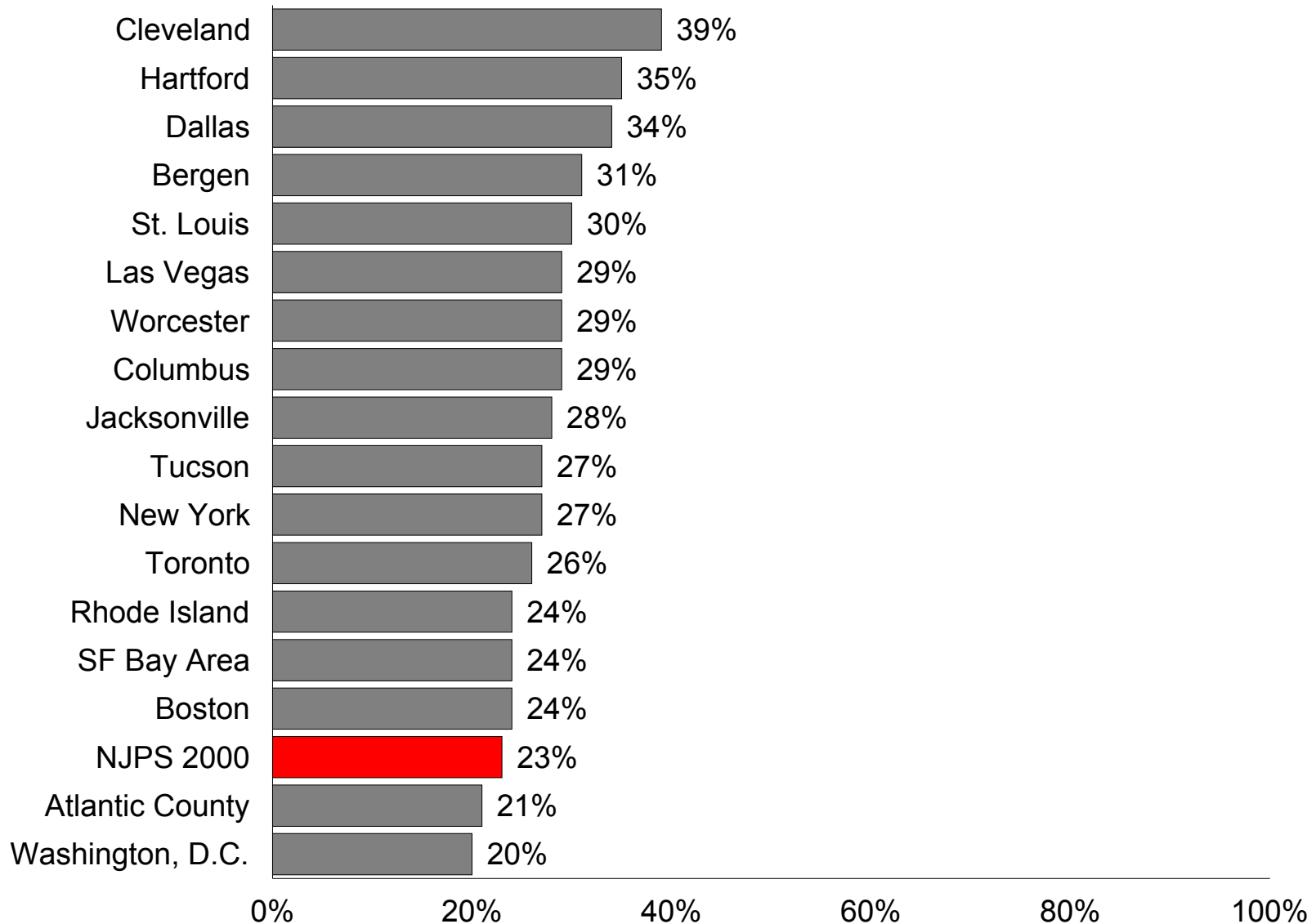

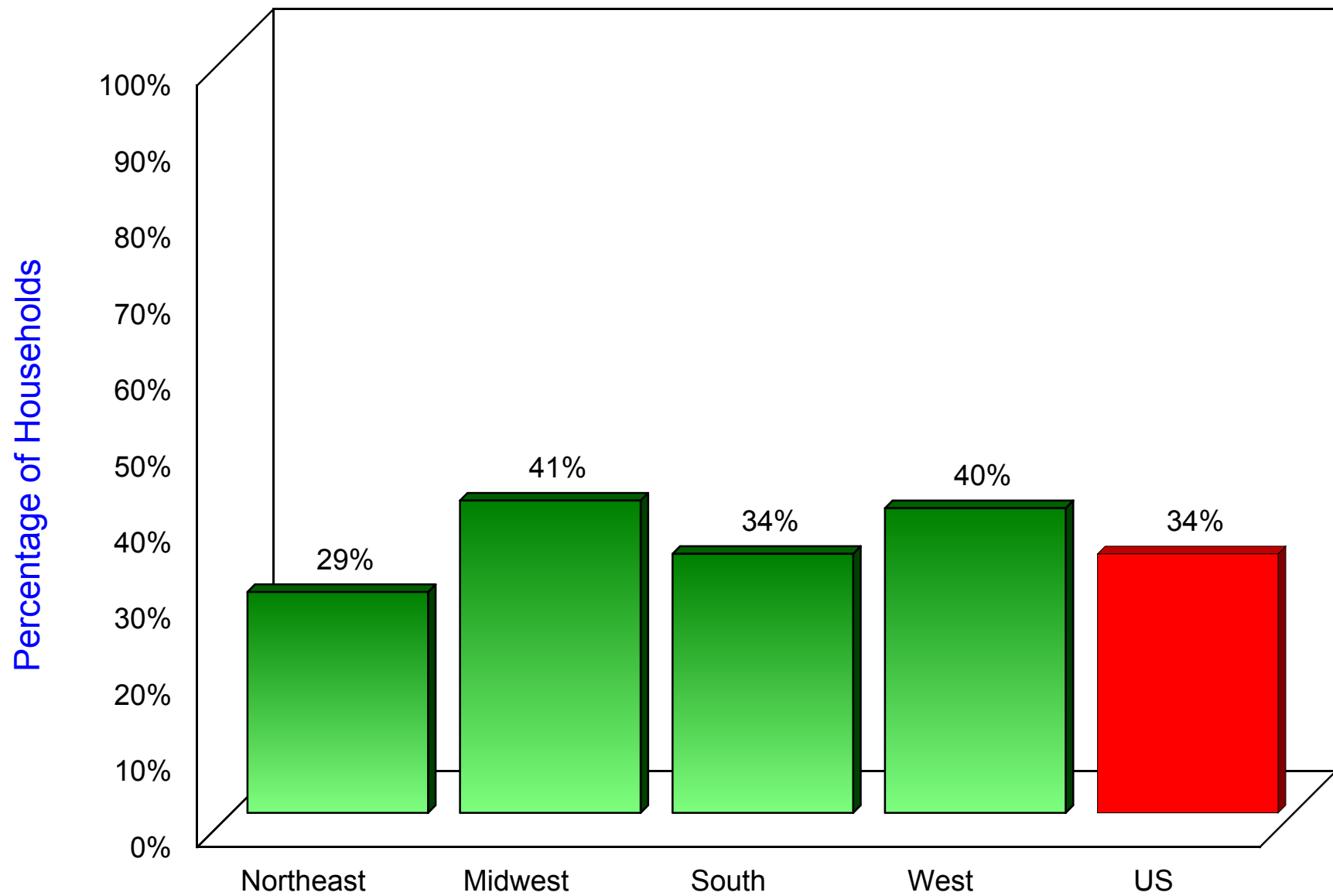

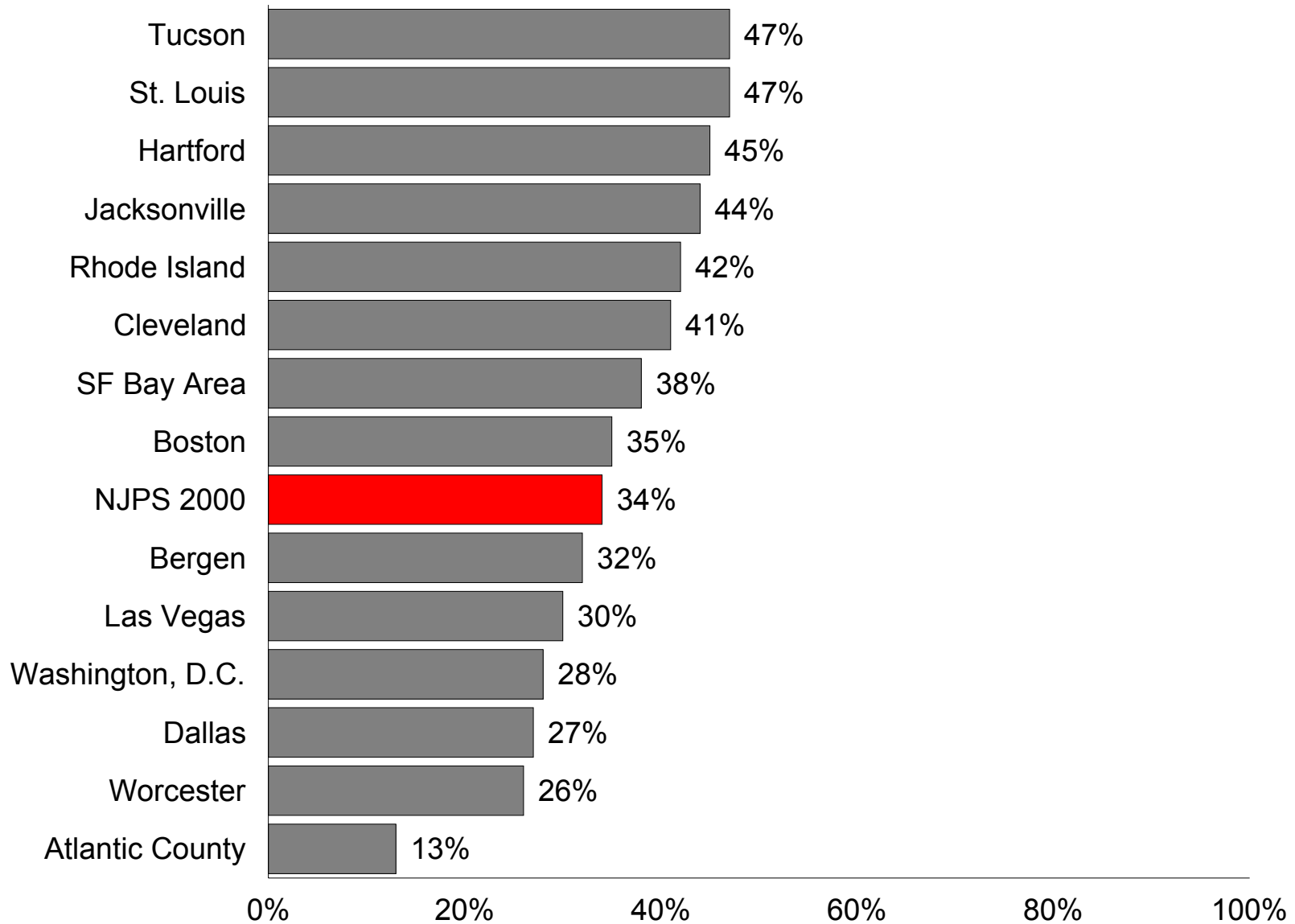


VOLUNTEERED FOR A NON-JEWISH ORGANIZATION IN THE PAST YEAR

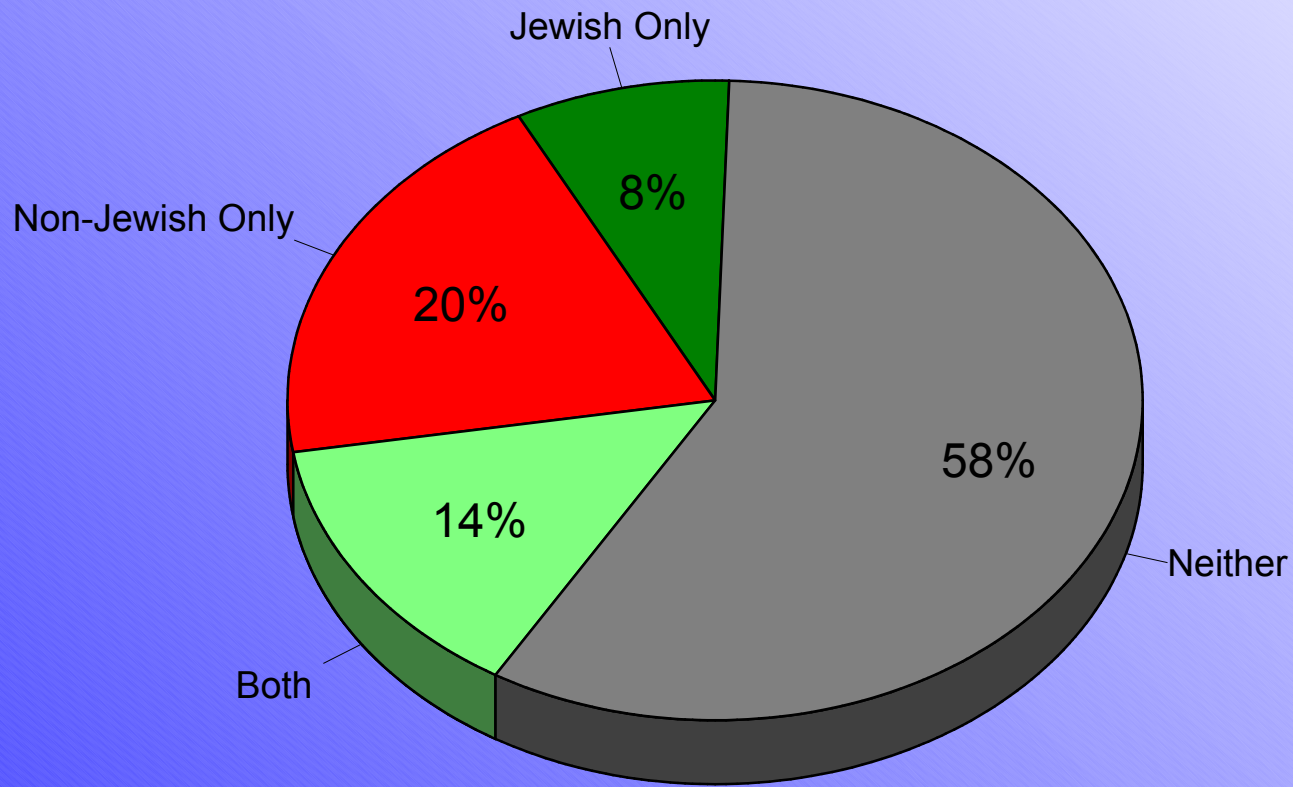

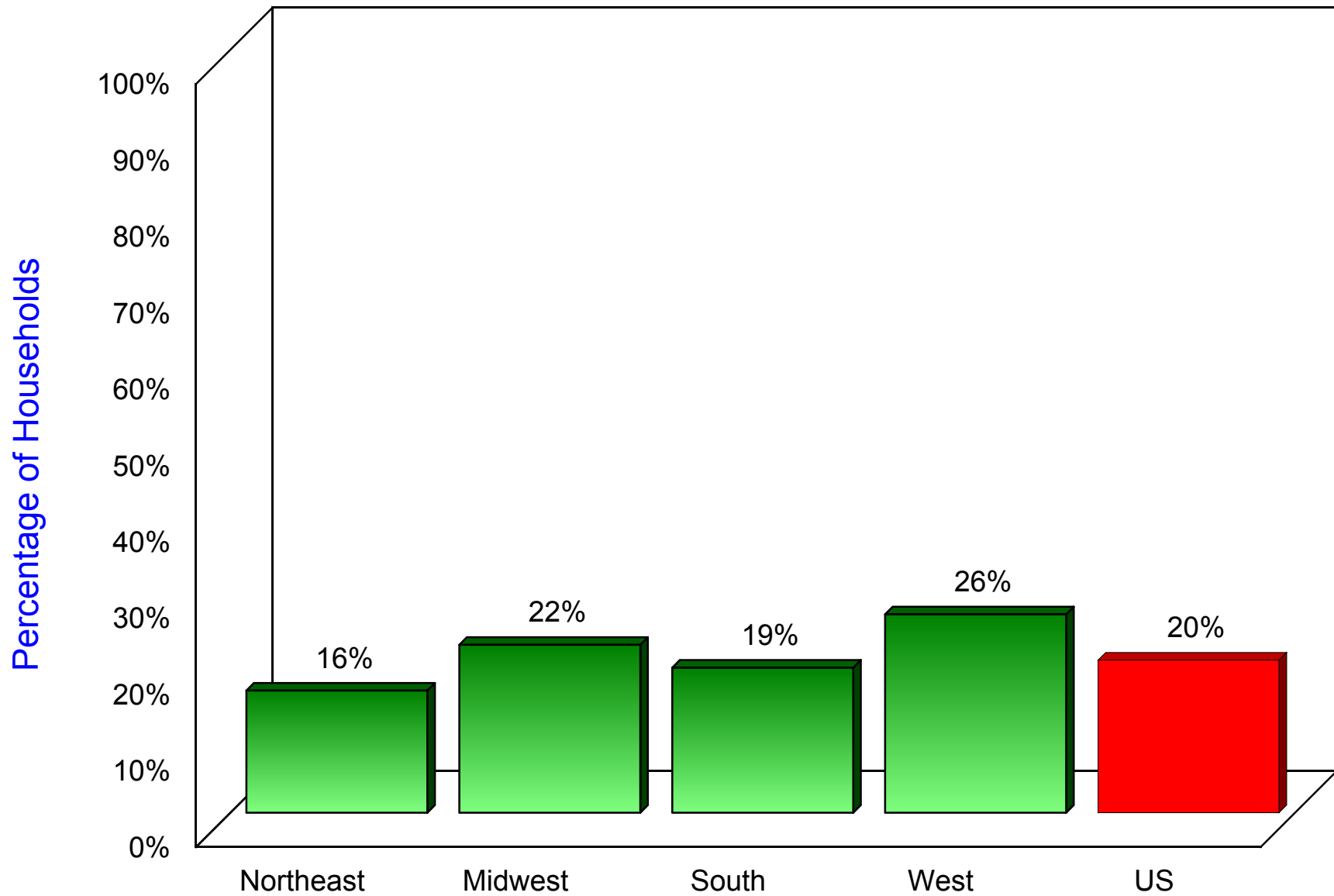
VOLUNTEERED FOR NON-JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS IN THE PAST YEAR
