


Figure D1. Dot Density Map of Jewish Households in the Greater Nashville Area

Note: 1 dot = 5 households




Figure D2. Dot Density Map of Synagogue Membership in the Greater Nashville Area




Figure D3. Dot Density Map of Households with Children in the Greater Nashville Area




Figure D4. Dot Density Map of Households with Seniors in the Greater Nashville Area

4 - The Temple Blue - Household with senior(s); Orange - Household without senior(s) Note: 1 dot = 5 households




Figure D5. Dot Density Map of Highly Involved Respondents in the Greater Nashville Area




Figure D6. Dot Density Map of Uninvolved Respondents in the Greater Nashville Area
