



#### 2021 American Jewish Committee Annual Survey Final Topline Results for U.S. Jewish Adults May 20, 2021

This study was conducted for The American Jewish Committee via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from March 25-May 9, 2021 among a nationally representative sample of 1,000 respondents aged 18 or older of Jewish religion or background.
